## **Important Information:**

- **NOTE:** Classes may not run in the order in the schedule.
- Pony Club Eventing Rules will be followed including suitable bits/tack for the Dressage phase and Rule and information can be found here: <https://pcuk.org/eventing/>
- Dressage Tests are free to download and are available here: [https://resources.pcuk.org/dressage/dressage\\_tests/](https://resources.pcuk.org/dressage/dressage_tests/)
- **Print your own numbers from [www.ponyclubresults.co.uk](http://www.ponyclubresults.co.uk)** and make **TWO** copies (1 for front of bib, 1 for back of bib). Number bibs **MUST** be worn for all phases
- A tack check will be in operation where hats will be checked for hat tags and body protector check for a current safety label. Please check the Rule for details. Hats can be tagged at the secretary if required.
- We hope to split Horse Trails sections - please state age on entry so we can split appropriately if possible.
- Rosettes to a minimum of 6<sup>th</sup> Place in each section (rosettes to 10<sup>th</sup> if entries allow) and rosettes to the Highest Placed Wokingham Member in each section.

## **Classes: To start at approx 09:00 am**

### **Class 1 - PC90**

Dressage Test: PC90 EVENTING TEST 2026

SJ and XC fences no higher than 90cm.

*Entry Fee: £80.00*

### **Class 2 - PC80**

Dressage Test: GRASSROOTS PC80 DRESSAGE TEST 2026

SJ and XC fences no higher than 80cm.

*Entry Fee: £80.00*

### **Class 3 - PC70**

Dressage Test: FOUNDATION PC70 DRESSAGE TEST 2026

SJ and XC fences no higher than 70cm.

*Entry Fee: £80.00*

### **Class 4 - PC 40-60**

Dressage Test: INTRODUCTION TO DRESSAGE TEST 2019

SJ and XC fences no higher than 60cm.

*Entry Fee: £70.00 – If sufficient numbers we will split by age group*

### **Class 5 – PC40**

Dressage Test: WALK & TROT DRESSAGE TEST 2026 - NUMBER 1

SJ and XC fences no higher than 40cm.

All competitors in this class can be assisted by voice/runner or on a lead rein connected to noseband.

*Entry Fee: £60.00 – If sufficient numbers we will split by age group*

## Rule and Conditions of Entry:

1. These Horse Trials are open to all but will be run in accordance with the rules of the Pony Club Eventing 2026. If you are unsure of the correct dress for yourself and turnout of your horse or pony in any of the three phases, please check Pony Club Eventing Rule Book 2026. It is the responsibility of competitors to comply with the Rules.

2. Vaccinations will be required according to Pony Club Rules 2026. It is illegal to travel your horse without its passport; spot checks may be carried out.
3. All riding hats must conform to Pony Club Rules 2026. Competitors may not compete without a tagged hat and must wear this at all times when mounted with the chinstrap fastened. A jockey skull with no fixed peak must be worn for all cross country.
4. Back protectors are compulsory for the cross country phase. Back protectors used for cross country must meet BETA 2018 Level 3 standard (blue and black label). Air Jackets **ARE NOT** to be worn under any item of clothing. If worn it must only be used in addition to a normal body protector which meets the above standard.
5. Medical Armbands are recommended and if used **MUST** be worn on the arm.
6. **Spurs:** Spurs are not permitted in classes 4 & 5. For classes 1-3, only blunt spurs, without rowels or sharp edges, and spurs that have a smooth rotating ball on the shank may be worn. If the spurs are curved, the curve must be downwards, and the shank must point straight to the back and not exceed 4cm in length. The measurement is taken from the boot to the end of the shank.  
Pony Club members may only wear spurs if wearing a Spurs Hat Tag.
7. **Dressage phase:** A whip with a maximum length of 102cm (measured up to the tassel) may be carried at PC70 and PC80, **but no whips are allowed at PC90.**
8. Electronic devices not allowed while rider is competing.
9. **Stopwatches** may only be worn at PC90 level. No stopwatches may be worn at PC70 and PC80 levels.
10. Numbers will not be given out for Number Bibs. Print your own numbers in font size 300. Bring your own number bib. Numbers will be available to download from Pony Club Results.
11. Withdrawals: Admin fees will be deducted from any refunds made before the closing date. No refunds will be made after the closing date unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced within one week of the event, subject to notification of withdrawal prior to the event.
12. In the event of cancellation prior to the event an admin charge will be made. If the event is cancelled on the day, there will be no refund.
13. Horse/pony may compete in only one class.
14. Competitors will be required to report to stewards for all phases 15 minutes before their time. Failure to comply will carry the risk of elimination.
15. All stallions must wear identifying disc on their bridle - written permission needed from DC/Centre Head.
16. **Legal Liability:** Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone or whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
17. **Insurance:** All non-members competing at a Pony Club organised event, should have their own Third-Party Liability Insurance.
18. **Health & Safety:** Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials and stewards.
19. **Reasonable Adjustment:** The Pony Club is committed to ensuring that, wherever possible, members are able to access all aspects of the Branch and Centre activities we offer. Reasonable Adjustments are any actions that help to reduce the effect of a disability or difficulty. Any requests for Reasonable Adjustment must be made by **Monday 6 June 2026**.
