Equipment Requirements

Hats

- Must meet current safety standards and have a **Pink BRC/BE/PC hat tag** before riding
- Tagging available at the secretaries on the day if needed

Body Protectors

- Mandatory for cross-country
- Must meet **Level 3 BETA 2018 (blue tag)**
- Air jackets may be worn in addition

Other

- Medical armbands required if relevant
 - Spurs only permitted with a **yellow hat tag**

Rules & Conditions of Entry

- Run under Pony Club Rules
 - Hard hats must meet current standards
 - Body protectors must meet current (2018) standard
 - Organisers may eliminate any horse/pony deemed unsuitable

(Failure to comply may result in a dog ban)
