Rules

1. Open to Pony Club members only. Entries may be limited if classes over-subscribed.
2. By entering you are agreeing to our terms and conditions. Failure to do so will result in elimination.
3. Withdrawals before the closing date will be 80% refunded, withdrawals after the closing date will not be refunded.
4. All entries are subject to a non-refundable booking fee which will be stated online on a per class basis
5. Scoring will be on Pony Club results at <https://www.ponyclubresults.co.uk/>
6. Please print your own numbers and wear a number bib.
7. Please report to the appropriate steward at least 5 minutes before your time for a tack inspection.
8. Every horse or pony to have current in date Flu vaccinations. Booster within 12 months. Passports with flu vaccination must accompany the pony. Spot checks may be carried out.
9. The decision of the judge is final and no objections shall be entertained



10. All droppings by your box to be picked up and taken home.
11. No dogs allowed
12. The organisers retain the right to disqualify any competitor for any cruelty or discourteousness.
13. Horses/ponies cannot compete more than once in each class.
14. No horse or pony under the age of four and no stallions may compete unless with the express permission of the event organiser.
15. Hard hats to current pony club standards must be worn with the chin strap fastened when mounted at all times. Hats must have a pony club tag. (Checking and tagging will be available on the day)
16. Back protectors to the current pony club standards must be worn when jumping cross country and are recommended when show jumping.
17. The age of the rider to be as at 1 January 2022.
18. The lunging or riding of horses/ponies in bearing, check or balancing reins is not permitted. Grass reins are permitted to be used.
19. The organisers reserve the right to cancel and/or amend any of the classes as they feel fit or to alter advertised times or refuse entry without stating reason.
