RING 1

INDIVIDUAL & TEAMS

8.30 AM START

Class 1a 40cm led – rider aged 10 years and under

Class 1b 40cm assisted – rider aged 12 years and under (this means someone in the ring with the rider, but not touching the pony)

Class 1c 40cm unassisted – rider aged 12 years and under (this means the rider is in the ring on their own)

Mini Champs Qualifiers - Branch Teams and IndividualsSingle phase jumps approx. height 40 cm

CLASS 2 50 cm – rider aged 12 years and under

Mini Champs Qualifier Branch Teams and Individuals unassisted

Unassisted Single phase jumps approx. height 50 cm

CLASS 3 60 cm – rider aged 14 years and under

Mini Champs Qualifier Branch Teams and Individuals unassisted

Unassisted Single phase jumps approx. height 60 cm

CLASS 4 70 cm Teams and Individuals

Single phase jumps approx. height 70 cm

CLASS 5 80 cm Teams and Individuals

Single phase jumps approx. height 80 cm

CLASS 6 90 cm Teams and Individuals

Single phase jumps approx. height 90 cm

RULES: Classes 1-6 will run in accordance with The Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2024.

RING 2

INDIVIDUALS 8.30 AM START

8.30 AM TO 11.30 AM Clear Round Jumping £3 per round or two rounds for £5 (same rider/pony combination)

CLASS 7 30 cm Individuals

Single phase jumps approx. height 30 cm Lead Rein, assisted or unassisted. The timed section will be judged on an optimum time.

CLASS 8 30 cm Ride and Run

Height 30 cm Lead Rein assisted or unassisted.

The Horse and Rider to jump the course of jumps then hands over a whip to the Runner who then jumps the course of jumps. The time is started when the Rider and Horse passes through the start and stopped when the Runner passes through the finish.

CLASS 9 40 cm Individuals

Single phase jumps approx. height 40 cm Lead Rein, assisted or unassisted. The timed section will be judged on an optimum time.

CLASS 10 40 cm Pairs

Single phase jumps approx. height 40 cm Lead Rein, assisted or unassisted.

The 1st combination to jump must hand over a whip to the 2nd combination having jumped the 1st round. The 2nd combination then jumps the 2nd round. The time is started when the 1st horse passes through the start and stopped when the 2nd horse passes through the finish.

CLASS 11 60 cm Pairs

Single phase jumps approx. height 60 cm can be assisted or unassisted.

The 1st combination to jump must hand over a whip to the 2nd combination having jumped the 1st round. The 2nd combination then jumps the 2nd round. The time is started when the 1st horse passes through the start and stopped when the 2nd horse passes through the finish.

ENTRIES FOR ALL CLASS: Only pre-entries made online will be accepted; entries will close on Monday 27th May 2024. Enter online at https://cravenpc.entrymaster.online Entries may be limited so early entry is advisable. No late entries or entries on the day for Ring 1. Entries on the day will be accepted for Ring 2 classes.

ENTRY FEES: All classes (with the exception of Class 10 and 11) £15 per rider per class, no additional fee for teams. Class 10 and 11 pairs will be £20 per pair. £4 First Aid Cover per rider.

START TIMES: Start times will be available on Thursday 30th May 2024 for Ring 1 classes at https://www.ponyclubresults.co.uk/ Approx. start times will be given for Ring 2 classes see above link.

RIDERS: Horses/ponies cannot compete more than once in each class.

NUMBERS: Please print your numbers, these will be available with start times. NUMBER BIBS to be worn by all competitors in Ring 1.

WITHDRAWALS / REFUNDS: If you need to withdraw, please update your booking on Entry Master. Please see Entry Master for details on withdrawals and refunds.

RESULTS: Live results for Ring 1 only will be posted on <u>www.ponyclubresults.co.uk</u> throughout the day.

TACK CHECK: For qualifying classes: 1a, 1b, 1c, 2 and 3 only. Items of tack and saddlery must comply with Pony Club regulations. Tack and hats will be checked before competing.

JUMPING CLASSES: All jumping on artificial surfaces. Course walk before each jumping class. All Classes to be run as a SINGLE PHASE competition with a Timed Section.

TEAMS:

- It is a condition of entry that all team managers inform competitors of the rules.
- Teams to be made up of 3 or 4 riders who are members of the same branch of the Pony Club and the best three scores will count.
- Team members jump in succession and there will be a drawn order for each team.
- Riders may compete in more than one team in each class on a different horse.
- Please could Team Managers declare your teams by 12 noon on Monday 27th May.
- Absolutely no substitutions/changes on the day!

QUALIFIERS:

- Classes 1a, 1b, 1c, 2 and 3 are qualifiers for the 2024 Pony Club Mini Champs to be held at Bicton Arena 22-25th August 2024.
- Any combination of horse and rider may not compete where the height is 30cm lower than that at which they have previously competed.
- The top Branch Team qualifies (no mixed teams) if there are five or less teams entered, or top two Branch Teams qualify if there are six or more teams entered and top three individuals qualify whether or not they are in a qualifying team.
- At least 2 members of the original team must be included in a championship team entry.
- Ages as at 1 January 2024

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. The Judges & Show Organiser's decision in all matters will be FINAL.
- 2. This event will be run under Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2024. It is your responsibility as a competitor to familiarise yourself with the current Pony Club Rulebook(s) before the competition.
- 3. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
- 4. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.
- 5. All non-Pony Club competitors are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third party cover. The Craven Hunt Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members and their insurance will not cover you.
- 6. Only Pony Club approved hats may be worn. All Pony Club members must wear a hat tagged with the current PC approved hat tag.
- 7. No earrings or any other jewellery.
- 8. The Organisers reserve the right to cancel, and/or amend, any of the classes as they feel fit or alter advertised time or refuse entry without stating reason.

- 9. Entries in all classes will be limited.
- 10. The Organiser may, at her discretion, alter the schedule/rules/running order as required.
- 11. No horse/pony under the age of 5 years old and no stallions may compete without permission of the Craven Hunt Pony Club District Commissioners.
- 12. At the competition horse/pony may ONLY be ridden by the rider who is competing at the competition.
- 13. Objections accompanied by a deposit of £10 must be made in writing to the Secretary within 15 minutes of the incident. The deposit will be forfeited if the objection is not sustained.
- 14. By entering you are agreeing to our terms and conditions. Failure to do so will result in Elimination.
- 15. NO DOGS are allowed on the college premises due to College Farm Policy.
- 16. NO SMOKING is allowed around the arenas, there are designated smoking areas in the lorry park.
- 17. No lunging permitted.
- 18. Please use the bins provided for litter and droppings.
- 19. Horses and ponies tied up outside horse boxes or trailers must not be left unsupervised.
- 20. Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
