CONDITIONS



- Online entries only at www.wylevalley.pc.entrymaster.online.co.uk Closing date Sunday 12th May 2024. £15 entry fee per class plus booking fee. (Medical fees are included).
- No refunds, except when a vet certificate is emailed within 24 hours after the event has taken place, refund minus 50% admin fee. In the unfortunate situation of the event having to cancel, all entries will be refunded minus an admin fee of £3 per horse and rider combination (booking fees are non refundable).
- Approximate start times will be available on Friday 17th May on <https://www.ponyclubresults.co.uk/>
- Teams of 3-4 with the best 3 scores to count.
- No rider may ride more than one horse or pony in one team.
- All classes will be run as a single phase with the second half of the course to be timed.
- Course walks will take place at regular intervals during the day.
- Classes 2 a, b, c, 3 and 4 – the top 2 Pony club teams and top 2 Pony Club individuals to qualify for the Bicton Mini Championships.
- No pony may enter more than 2 classes.

GENERAL RULES

- The decision of the judges shall be final and no objections shall be entertained.
- The organisers retain the right to disqualify any competitor for any cruelty or dis-courteousness.
- No horse or pony under the age of 5 may compete.
- Hard hats to the Pony Clubs current standards must be worn with the chin strap fastened. Pony Club members must display the pink hat tag.
- Numbers to be printed in advance and attached to the rider, or inserted into the number bibs.
- Whips 2023 ruling will be enforced on the day.
- The lunging of horses / ponies is not permitted
- Riding of horses / ponies in bearing or check reins is not permitted. Balance reins may only be used in classes 1, 2 and 3.
- All dogs must be kept on a lead
- The organisers reserve the right to cancel and / or amend any of the classes as they feel fit, or to alter advertised times or refuse entry, without stating reason.
- Outside assistance will be penalised.
- All classes as per Pony Club Showjumping rules 2024.
- Please pick up all horse droppings.
- Please do not leave horses unattended tied to trailers or lorries.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present.
