- 1. All entries for Class 1 must be age validated by the Branch DC
- 2. All entries are subject to a non-refundable booking fee
- 3. As this is an Area competition, you must have been selected by your DC to enter
- 4. Rider membership number is mandatory

- 6. Late entries will only be accepted providing there is space.
- 7. Substitutions post closing date may only be made in accordance with the Pony Club Eventing Rules 2024. Please email your changes to <a href="mailto:lindsaybryars@icloud.com">lindsaybryars@icloud.com</a>

## **RULES:**

- 1. The competition will be run in accordance with the Pony Club Eventing Rules 2024, new rules in **BOLD** below
- 2. In the event of abandonment, 25% of each individual entry fee will be retained to defray expenses.
- 3. Refunds:
- i. 100% of Entry Fee up to 11am on Friday 12th July 2024
- ii. No refunds after 11am on Friday 12th July 2024
- 4. The Judges' decision is final. In the event of a dispute or objection arising, an objection in writing together with £50 must be lodged with the Secretary by the Branch representative within 30 minutes of the incident. Any appeal will be heard by the Jury of Appeal. The decision of the Jury will be final.
- 5. Hats must be tagged with a PINK tag
- 6. SKULL CAPS WITH NO FIXED PEAK MUST BE WORN AT ALL LEVELS OF XC
- 7. BODY PROTECTORS MUST BE TO BETA 2018 LEVEL 3 STANDARD (BLUE AND BLACK LABEL).
- 8. NO COMMANDERS IN DRESSAGE PC80 & ABOVE
- 9. PC80 XC TIME PENALTIES FOR GOING TOO SLOW, NO STOP WATCHES ALLOWED
- 10. NO WHIPS PERMITTED IN DRESSAGE PC90 & ABOVE
- 11. White, Beige, Cream, Dark or Muted coloured Jodphurs are allowed in all phases.
- 12. Three competitor numbers must be printed on A4 by competitors and brought to the competition. No printed numbers or number bibs will be provided by the Organisers. Print numbers from <a href="https://www.ponyclubresults.co.uk">www.ponyclubresults.co.uk</a>. Please display one number in the front window of your vehicle.
- 13. Courses will be open for walking on Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> July from 2pm. **NO CARS ON XC COURSE**, PLEASE PARK AT THE QUEEN'S BUILDING & WALK DOWN TO THE COURSE
- 14. Please obey parking stewards at all times. PC teams will be parked together.

- 15. All competitors must travel with equine passports and comply with the Pony Club Vaccination Rule in the Eventing Rule Book 2024. District Commissioners must validate compliance at the time of entry.
- 16. Photographic Rights unless stated competitors and their parents/guardians are deemed to have given permission for any photographic and/or film or TV footage taken of persons or horses/ponies taking part in Pony Club events to be used and published in any media whatsoever for editorial purposes, press information or advertising by or on behalf of the Pony Club and/or Official Sponsors of the Pony Club.
- 17. The Organisers reserve the right to alter or amend any aspect of the competition.
- 18. Please pick up all droppings, hay & litter from around your trailer/lorry
- 19. Dogs must be kept on short leads at all times
