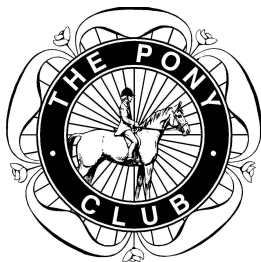

Class 1a 50cm open (Riders not to have competed at 75cm or above)

Class 1b As above. Riders 14yrs or under

Class 2a 60cm open

Class 2b As above. Riders 14yrs or under

Class 3a 70cm open

Class 3b As above. Riders 14yrs or under

Class 4a 80cm open

Class 4b As above. Riders 14yrs or under

Class 5 90cm open

Class 6 1m open

Riders age will be taken as of 1st January 2025

Classes a and b will run concurrently

All classes will run single phase

In a "single phase" class faults are accumulated in both sections with all riders going through to the timed part of the course against the clock.

SPARSHOLT REQUIRE ALL HORSES TO BE UP TO DATE WITH THEIR 12 MONTH EQUINE INFLUENZA VACCINATIONS. PLEASE ENSURE YOU HAVE YOUR PASSPORT WITH YOU AS EVIDENCE OF THIS.

Pony Club rider wearing spurs must have achieved the C+ riding Test or Spurs achievement badge and have a yellow hat tag as evidence of this. Spurs may not be worn by any pony club members without a yellow hat tag.

All Pony Club members must have a pink tag to show their hat is up to standard.

RULES AND CONDITIONS

Please check your back protectors against the new Pony Club rules. As of 1st Feb 2024 back protectors, if worn, must be compliant with the latest standard (2018 blue black label).

Purple on white 2009 standard is no longer permitted.

1. This competition will be judged under current Pony Club 2025 Show Jumping rules.
2. Riders must wear riding hats to current approved British Standards, with the chinstrap properly fastened at all times when mounted. Helmets must have plain, dark coloured covers.
3. All competitors have a responsibility to ensure that they and their horses are fit and at an appropriate standard to compete in the event.
4. NO DOGS are allowed at the Equine Centre.
5. No refund of entry fees will be made unless a Vet\Doctors certificate is produced.
6. The Organiser reserves the right to cancel any show, alter classes and refuse any entries without explanation. In the event of cancellation, refunds will be made less £3.00 per entry form to cover administration costs.
7. All horses and ponies must be 4 years old or over.
8. Horses may be ridden once only in each class, and may not compete in more than 3 classes.
9. Please use the bins provided for litter and droppings.
10. In the interests of health and safety, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and obey the instructions of the Organiser and Stewards.
11. For the avoidance of doubt and unless explicitly stated to the contrary, medical facilities will be limited to standard NHS accident and emergency callout.
12. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
13. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.
14. **All non Pony Club competitors are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third party cover. The Royal Artillery Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non Members and their insurance will not cover you.**
