Clear Round Jumping - Outdoor

Running all day, £5 Per Round, with a rosette if clear. Pay cash or card on the day.

All Show Jumping Classes - Indoors:

All classes are Single Phase Show Jumping where Competitors jump the whole course with the second half to be timed. Classes are open to Pony Club Members and Non-Members

Qualifying Classes for the Pony Club Mini Championships 2026: Classes 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5

CLASS 1: 40cm Lead Rein Single Phase Show Jumping – rider aged 8 years and under on 1st January 2026, no whips or spurs allowed – sponsored by Johnson Valves



CLASS 2: 40cm Assisted Single Phase Show Jumping – rider aged 11 years and under on 1st January 2026 (this means someone in the ring with the rider, but not touching the pony) – sponsored by Johnson Valves

CLASS 3: 40cm Unassisted Single Phase Show Jumping – rider aged 13 years and under on 1st January 2026 (this means the rider is in the ring on their own) - Sponsored by Johnson Valves

CLASS 4: 50cm Single Phase Show Jumping – sponsored by The Hunting Stock

CLASS 5: 60cm Single Phase Show Jumping – sponsored by NFU Mutual Market

CLASS 6: 70cm Single Phase Show Jumping – sponsored by M&M Timber

CLASS 7: 80cm Single Phase Show Jumping – sponsored by South Coast Property **Developments & Design Limited**

CLASS 8: 90cm Single Phase Show Jumping – sponsored by Bear Construction

CLASS 9: 1m Single Phase Show Jumping - sponsored by Gable & Glass

A combination is unable to compete in the 50cm (Class 4), or higher, if they have

competed in either 40cm lead rein (Class 1) or 40cm assisted (Class 2).

Ponies are only allowed to compete in two classes during the day.

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

All Classes to be run under the Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2024

Entries are accepted and admission granted only subject to the following conditions, which are deemed to have been accepted by each competitor:

- 1. All entries are subject to a non-refundable booking fee which will be stated online on a per class basis
- 2. All entries and changes must be done online, before the close of entries. If you would like to edit your horse or rider details before the closing date of the event, please login to your Horse Events account and edit your booking under the 'MY BOOKING' Tab. If you would like to change the class please email info@horse-events.co.uk and if there is space available we will do this for you. For ALL changes of horse and rider substitutions after the closing date there is a £5 charge please fill out the following form online at: https://www.horse-events.co.uk/rider-horse-substitutions-form/
- 3. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organiser and all officials and stewards.
- 4. It is a condition of entry that each competitor shall indemnify the above mentioned against such matter aforesaid.
- 5. Dress & Saddlery Rules as per the Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2025 and, for PC members, the Pony Club Spurs Rule on the use of spurs. Copies of both will be with the Secretary.
- 6. The judge's decision is final. Any objection must be made in writing to the Secretary with a deposit of £20 no later than 20 minutes after the end of the class. The deposit will only be returned if the objection is upheld.
- 7. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without stating a reason for doing so and also reserve the right to eliminate any competitor who in their opinion places her/himself or others in danger or fails to observe rules.
- 8. No refunds after the withdrawal date for whatever reason. Before this date, full refunds to be given less any booking fees.
- 9. All horses/ponies must be compliant with the current Pony Club minimum vaccinations requirements (https://pcuk.org/equine-welfare/)
- 10. Horses or ponies must be 5 years or over on the day of the show and no stallions without written permission from the DC.
- 11. No horses or ponies may be ridden other than by the competitor on the day of the competition.
- 12. Horses and ponies must be ridden at a walk unless in a competition or warm-up area.
- 13. All dogs must be kept on a short lead at all times.
- 14. All droppings and hay to be picked up and taken home.
- 15. No horse/ponies are to be left unattended when tied to the lorry/trailer.
- 16. In the event of cancellation notification will be posted on the Hursley PC website. Monies will be refunded less £3.00 per entry administration fee.
- 17. All non-Pony Club competitors are not covered by The Pony Club Insurance and must have their own third-party cover. The Hursley Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-members and their insurance will not cover you.
- 18. There will be a photographer at this event. It is the responsibility of any individual not wishing to be photographed to notify them directly.
- 19. A pony may only be ridden in two classes
