

Royal Windsor Horse Show Invitational Tetrathlon - 16th & 17th May 2026

This is a prestigious event for a junior PC member, who can only compete in this event once. They represent Southern England, with one member selected from each Area: 11, 13 and 14, in a mixed team of 2 girls and 1 boy, or 2 boys and 1 girl. There is a rotation of the Areas selecting a boy competitor, if required. The competition has 24 competitors from 8 regions.

This showcase event requires an elite performance as well as excellent ambassador qualities from The Pony Club competitors. The riding phase is show jumping at 90cm, with a slip rail, under a somewhat pressurised atmosphere. Those applying should be prepared to offer their pony to be ridden by a competitor from Northern Ireland if requested. They should be a current, active PC member and their application should be supported by their branch Tetrathlon manager.

Members applying please reply with the following information:

- Name (as on Pelham), date of birth (12 yr - 14yrs on 1st January 2026), PC branch, the latest PC test passed.
- Complete the attached record sheet with 2024/25 Triathlon results, 2025 Tetrathlon results at Junior level including short comments where appropriate. Plus 2025/26 Triathlon results to date. Details must be presented on the form attached.
- Details of their pony: age, height, competition record with this pony, including show jumping results in 2025 (4 or 5 SJ results @ 90cm+, can include eventing). If the pony is likely to be different from the pony they have competed in 2025, please give details and results of both ponies.
- Dates and activity of 3 working rallies or team training sessions which the candidate has attended in 2025.
- Parent's/guardian's contact details.

In the event of equally strong candidates, the 3rd year Junior will take priority. All details will be considered by both the Area Tetrathlon co-ordinator and Richard Mosley, Southern England Tetrathlon co-ordinator.
