Class 1a: **40cm Riders 10 yrs and under** and who have not competed at 65 cm or above (assisted) Individuals only

Class 1b: **40cm Riders 14 yrs and under**, as above, (unassisted) Individuals only

Class 2a: **50cm Riders 10 yrs and under** and who have not competed at 75 cm or above (assisted) Individuals only

Class 2b: **50cm Riders 14 yrs and under**, as above, (unassisted) Individuals only

Class 3: 60cm Teams and Individuals - not to have competed at 80cm or above

Class 4: 70cm Teams and Individuals – not to have competed at 90cm or above

Class 5: 80cm Teams and Individuals

Class 6: 90cm Individuals only

Class 7: 100cm Individuals only

Riders age as at 1st January 2026

The classes will be run as Single Phase. See rules for definition.

All classes will run in accordance with The Pony Club Show Jumping 2026 Rule Book.

ENTRY FEE: £15 per individual all classes after closing date £20 per individual. Entries will be limited and will be accepted on a first come first served basis. **All entries must be online**, please follow this link to **ENTRYMASTER** **No entries on the day!**

NO REFUNDS: after closing date unless we can replace you from a waitlist. We do hold **waitlists in all classes** so if you need to withdraw please do so early so we can replace you.

PRIZES: Individual rosettes to 8th and Teams to 4th place. Dismounted prizegiving after the class.

- **ALL JUMPING CLASSES WILL BE IN A DRAWN ORDER AND TIMES MUST BE STRICTLY ADHERED TO.**
- **ONLY 6 RIDERS IN COLLECTING RING AND WARM UP AT ANYONE TIME.**

- SPARSHOLT REQUIRE ALL HORSES TO BE UP TO DATE WITH THEIR 12 MONTH EQUINE INFULENZA VACCINATIONS. PLEASE ENSURE YOU HAVE YOUR PASSPORT WITH YOU AS EVIDENCE OF THIS.

RULES

1. Hard Hats Must be worn with chinstrap fastened at all times when mounted. Hats must be Pony Club Approved and Tagged with a current PINK Pony Club Hat Tag, also a YELLOW TAG if wearing spurs

Hat standard: PAS015: 1998 or 2011 with BSI Kite mark, VG1 with BSI Kite mark, Snell E2001 with the official Snell label & number, ASTM-F1163 2004a onwards with the SEI mark, AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards

2. Organiser's reserve the right to divide or amalgamate classes according to entries.
3. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry made by any person, if they so shall deem it right to do so, without giving any reason.
4. The Judge's decision shall be **final** at all times.
5. Entries will not be refunded after the closing date unless we can replace you off the waitlist.
6. If we are unable to run refunds will be issued minus an admin fee.
7. All classes will run under the 2026 Pony Club rules.
8. Working in for all classes, must be **by competitor** with a class entry on that pony.
9. No more than two classes per rider/horse combination.
10. **Single Phase Definition.** The first 5 to 7 fences will not be against the clock but will have a time allowed. Unless eliminated, continue straight on to the next 5 to 7 fences without a bell being rung. These fences will be higher than the first half and will be against the clock. A maximum 12 obstacles in all. Competitors placed on total faults and time in second half.
11. **PLEASE TREAT OUR JUDGES AND STEWARDS WITH RESPECT AT ALL TIMES.**
12. **BY ENTERING YOU ARE AGREEING TO OUR TERMS AND CONDITIONS. FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN ELIMINATION. WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE AN ENTRY.**

Pony Club members wearing spurs must have achieved the C+ riding Test or Spurs achievement badge and have a yellow hat tag as evidence of this.

Spurs may not be worn by any Pony Club members without a yellow hat tag.
