1. All entries for Classes 1 and 3 must be age validated by the Branch DC
2. **All entries are subject to a non-refundable booking fee**
3. As this is an Area competition, you must have been selected by your DC to enter
4. Rider membership number is mandatory
5. If you need to cancel an entry, change details or any other queries before the closing date, please email office@racsaddleclub.co.uk
6. Late entries will only be accepted providing there is space.
7. Substitutions post closing date may only be made in accordance with the Pony Club Eventing Rules 2026. Please email your changes to office@racsaddleclub.co.uk

RULES:

1. The competition will be run in accordance with the Pony Club Eventing Rules 2026, new rules in **BOLD** below
2. In the event of abandonment, 25% of each individual entry fee will be retained to defray expenses.
3. Refunds:
100% of Entry Fee up to 11am on Friday 12th June 2026
No refunds after 11am on Friday 12th June 2026
4. The Judges' decision is final. In the event of a dispute or objection arising, **an objection in writing together with £50 must be lodged with the Secretary by the Branch representative within 30 minutes of the incident.** Any appeal will be heard by the Jury of Appeal. The decision of the Jury will be final.
5. Hats must be tagged with a PINK tag
6. **SKULL CAPS WITH NO FIXED PEAK MUST BE WORN AT ALL LEVELS OF XC**
7. **BODY PROTECTORS MUST BE TO BETA 2018 LEVEL 3 STANDARD (BLUE AND BLACK LABEL).**
8. Spurs – may not be worn by a Pony Club member at a Pony Club activity or event unless that member has passed either the Pony Club C+ Riding Test or the Pony Club Spurs Test. Hats must be tagged with the yellow spurs tag.

9. PC70 and PC 70+
Combination of horse and rider are NOT eligible if they have:
Previously completed at an PC80 or above Area or Regional competition for Eventing
Achieved more than two cross-country rounds with no jumping penalties at BE (or EI)
80 or above.
PC80
Combination of horse and rider are NOT eligible if they have:
Previously completed at PC90 or above in any Eventing Area competitions.
Achieved more than two cross-country rounds with no jumping penalties at BE (or EI)
90 or above.
10. NO COMMANDERS IN DRESSAGE PC80 & ABOVE
11. PC80 XC TIME PENALTIES FOR GOING TOO SLOW, NO STOP WATCHES ALLOWED
12. NO WHIPS PERMITTED IN DRESSAGE PC90 & ABOVE
13. White, Beige, Cream, Dark or Muted coloured Jodphurs are allowed in all phases.
14. Three competitor numbers must be printed on A4 by competitors and brought to the competition. No printed numbers or number bibs will be provided by the Organisers. Print numbers from www.ponyclubresults.co.uk. **Please display one number in the front window of your vehicle.**
15. Courses will be open for walking on Saturday 20th June from 2pm. **NO CARS ON XC COURSE,**
16. Please obey parking stewards at all times. PC teams will be parked together.
17. All competitors must travel with equine passports and comply with the Pony Club Vaccination Rule in the Eventing Rule Book 2026. District Commissioners must validate compliance at the time of entry.
18. Photographic Rights – unless stated competitors and their parents/guardians are deemed to have given permission for any photographic and/or film or TV footage taken of persons or horses/ponies taking part in Pony Club events to be used and published in any media whatsoever for editorial purposes, press information or advertising by or on behalf of the Pony Club and/or Official Sponsors of the Pony Club.
19. The Organisers reserve the right to alter or amend any aspect of the competition.
20. Please pick up all droppings, hay & litter from around your trailer/lorry
21. Dogs must be kept on short leads at all times
