CONDITIONS

- Online entries only at <https://bsvpc.entrymaster.online> Closing – Monday 13th April 2026. £15 entry fee per class. Paramedic first aid cover provided by Dorset Medical Services £3 per rider.
- No refunds after the closing date, except with a vet certificate.
- The organisers reserve the right to cancel and/or amend any of the classes as they feel fit, or to alter advertised times or refuse entry, without stating reason.
- No pony may enter more than 2 classes.
- Teams of 3 or 4 with best 3 scores to count.
- DCs or Branch Team Manager to declare teams by Monday 13th April via Entrymaster or email Veryan Gould.
- Start times will be available on Friday 17th April on www.ponyclubresults.co.uk
- All classes will be run as single phase with the second half of the course to be timed.
- Course walks will take place at regular intervals throughout the day.

Teams and individuals will have the opportunity to qualify for the Championships at Bicton Arena at the end of August 2026. Qualification is as follows:

- If five or fewer Branch teams (not mixed teams) enter this competition, the top team will qualify.
- If six or more Branch teams (not mixed teams) enter, the top two teams will qualify.
- The top three individuals, whether or not they are part of a qualifying team, will also qualify.
- If a combination is placed 1st–6th at mini championships 2025. They are unable to compete at the same level at mini champs 2026

This applies to the following show jumping levels: Led 40cm, Assisted 40cm, Unassisted 40cm, 50cm, and 60cm.

- The decision of the judges shall be final, and no objections shall be entertained.
- The organisers retain the right to disqualify any competitor for any cruelty or discourteousness.
- Dress, Saddlery & Competition Rules – as per the Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2026.
- Hard hats to current Pony Club standards must be worn with the chin strap fastened. Pony Club members must display the pink hat tag and yellow if wearing spurs.
- Numbers to be printed in advance and attached to rider, or inserted into number bibs.
- Horses or ponies must be 60 months or over on the day of the show and no stallions without written permission from the DC. No horses or ponies may be ridden other than by the competitor on the day of the competition.
- Horses and ponies must be ridden at a walk unless in a competition or warm-up area.
- All horses/ponies must be compliant with the current Pony Club minimum vaccinations requirements (<https://pcuk.org/equine-welfare/>)
- Outside assistance will be penalised (except in Class 1A and 1B).

CONDITIONS

HEALTH AND SAFETY
