## **RING 1**

### **8.30 AM START**

**Class 1 30cm – rider 10 years and under (may be led/ assisted)** *Please note this class is not a qualifier*

**Class 2a 40cm led – rider aged 8 years and under** (No whips or spurs)

**Class 2b 40cm assisted – rider aged 11 years and under** (this means someone in the ring with the rider, giving verbal encouragement / direction but not touching the pony **and not jumping the jumps** (parent may run next to but must go around the fences - new rule for 2026)

**Class 2c 40cm unassisted – rider aged 12 years and under** (this means the rider is in the ring on their own)

## **RING 2**

### **CLEAR ROUND 8.30 AM START**

**8.30 AM to approx. 2PM Clear Round Jumping** (Pay on the day – cash)  
**£5 per round or two rounds for £7 (same rider/pony combination)**

**ENTRIES FOR ALL CLASS:** Only pre-entries made online will be accepted; entries will close on Monday 11th May 2026. Enter online at <https://cravenpc.entrymaster.online> Entries may be limited so early entry is advisable. No late entries or entries on the day for Ring 1.

**ENTRY FEES:** All classes £16 per rider per class, no additional fee for teams. £4 First Aid Cover per rider.

**START TIMES:** Start times will be available no earlier than 6pm Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> May 2026 at <https://www.ponyclubresults.co.uk/>

**RIDERS:** Horses/ponies cannot compete more than once in each class.

**NUMBERS:** Please print your numbers, these will be available with start times. **NUMBER BIBS** to be worn by all competitors.

**WITHDRAWALS / REFUNDS:** If you need to withdraw, please update your booking on Entry Master. Please see Entry Master for details on withdrawals and refunds.

**RESULTS:** Live results will be posted on [www.ponyclubresults.co.uk](http://www.ponyclubresults.co.uk) throughout the day.

**TACK CHECK:** For qualifying classes: 2a, 2b, 2c, 3 and 4 only. Items of tack and saddlery must comply with Pony Club regulations. Tack and hats will be checked before competing. Spurs may only be worn by those who have passed the PC assessment/ or C+ holders and are wearing the appropriate yellow hat tag.

**JUMPING CLASSES:** All jumping on artificial surfaces. Course walk before each jumping class. All Classes to be run as a SINGLE PHASE competition with a Timed Section.

## TEAMS:

- It is a condition of entry that all team managers inform competitors of the rules.
- Teams to be made up of 3 or 4 riders who are members of the same branch of the Pony Club and the best three scores will count.
- Team members jump in succession and there will be a drawn order for each team.
- Riders may compete in more than one team in each class on a different horse.
- Please could Team Managers declare your teams by 12 noon on Tuesday 12th May 2026.
- Absolutely no substitutions/changes on the day!

## QUALIFIERS:

- Classes 2a, 2b, 2c, 3 and 4 are qualifiers for the 2026 Pony Club Mini Champs to be held at Bicton Arena
- Any combination of horse and rider may not compete where the height is more than 20cm lower than that at which they have previously competed.
- The top Branch Team qualifies (no mixed teams) if less than 5 teams are entered and top two Branch Teams qualify if there are 5 or more teams entered and top three individuals qualify whether or not they are in a qualifying team.
- A combination may only compete in **one** section of **Class 2**.
- At least 2 members of the original team must be included in a championship team entry.
- If a combination is placed in the top 6 at the Championships, they are unable to compete at the same level the following year.
- Ages as at 1 January 2026

## **RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

1. The Judges & Show Organiser's decision in all matters will be FINAL.
2. This event will be run under Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2026. It is your responsibility as a competitor to familiarise yourself with the current Pony Club Rulebook(s) before the competition.
3. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
4. **Horses / ponies must be 5 years of age or over to participate in PC Show Jumping Events. In their first eligible year, they must be at least 60 months old to compete. Their next birthday will be on 1<sup>st</sup> January thereafter.**
5. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.
6. All non-Pony Club competitors are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third party cover. The Craven Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members and their insurance will not cover you.
7. Only Pony Club approved hats may be worn. All Pony Club members must wear a hat tagged with the current PC approved hat tag.
8. The wearing of any sort of jewellery when handling or riding a horse/pony is not recommended and if done at any Pony Club activity, is done so at the risk of the member/their parent/guardian. However, to stop any risk or injury, necklaces and bracelets (other than medical) must be removed, as must larger and more pendulous pieces of jewellery (including those attached to piercings), which create a risk of injury to the body part through which they are secured.
9. Hair-must be tied up and back (preferably in a hairnet) securely, in a safe manner to reduce the risk of hair being caught and to prevent scalp injuries.
10. The Organisers reserve the right to cancel, and/or amend, any of the classes as they feel fit or alter advertised time or refuse entry without stating reason.
11. Entries in all classes will be limited.
12. The Organiser may, at her discretion, alter the schedule/rules/running order as required.
13. No stallions may compete without permission of the Craven Hunt Pony Club District Commissioners
14. At the competition horse/pony may ONLY be ridden by the rider who is competing at the competition.
15. Objections accompanied by a deposit of £10 must be made in writing to the Secretary within 15 minutes of the incident. The deposit will be forfeited if the objection is not sustained.

16. By entering you are agreeing to our terms and conditions. Failure to do so will result in Elimination.
17. NO DOGS are allowed due to College Farm Policy.
18. NO SMOKING is allowed around the arenas, there are designated smoking areas in the lorry park.
19. No lunging permitted.
20. Please use the bins provided for litter and droppings.
21. Horses and ponies tied up outside horse boxes or trailers must not be left unsupervised.
22. Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
