<b>Entry Guidelines</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Eligibility: Please refer to Rule 4 of The Pony Club Dressage Rules 2026.</li> <li>• All entries should be made online using <a href="http://www.horse-events.co.uk">www.horse-events.co.uk</a> by the District Commissioners of each Branch.</li> <li>• All entries are subject to a non-refundable booking fee as stated online.</li> <li>• IF YOU HAVE ANY DIFFICULTIES ENTERING ONLINE, PLEASE DO NOT HESITATE TO CONTACT HORSE- EVENTS</li> </ul>
<b>Substitutions</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• After the closing date, substitutions may only be made as per Rule 8 of The Pony Club Dressage Rules 2026.</li> <li>• There will be an administration fee of £5.00.</li> <li>• Please email your changes after the closing date to: <a href="http://www.horse-events.co.uk">www.horse-events.co.uk</a></li> </ul>
<b>Withdrawals &amp; Refunds</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Full refunds will be given up until the closing entry date of the competition minus an admin fee of £1.45.</li> <li>• After the closing date, no refunds will be made without a Doctor's / Vet's certificate produced no later than 24 hours after the event. If produced after this no refunds will be given.</li> <li>• In the event of abandonment, 50% of the entry fee will be refunded.</li> <li>• All changes are to be made by the District Commissioner of each branch ONLY.</li> <li>• For ALL after the closing date there is a £5 charge. # COMPETITION DETAILS & RULES

<p><b>Spurs</b></p>	<p>May not be worn by a Pony Club member at a Pony Club activity or event unless that member has passed either the Pony Club C+ Riding Test or the Pony Club Spurs Test. The competitor's hat must bear the Yellow Hat Tag to indicate eligibility to wear spurs.</p>
<p><b>Hat Tag</b></p>	<p>All riders must be wearing the correct hat tags – this will be checked.</p>
<p><b>Tack Check</b></p>	<p>Competitors must present themselves for tack check at least 30 minutes before competition time.</p>
<p><b>Pony Club Badge</b></p>	<p>The official metal membership badge should be worn on the left side of the rider's jacket.</p>
<p><b>Eligibility Guidelines</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Entries must be made in accordance with Rule 3 of the Pony Club Dressage Rule Book 2026. It is the responsibility of each District Commissioner/Centre Proprietor to ensure that the eligibility of horse and rider are adhered to both when entering the competition and on the day, with particular attention paid to:</li> <li>• Foundation PC70 Dressage Test (Regional Championships): is for riders aged 13 years and under on 1st January 2026. Combination of horse and rider are not eligible to enter if they have completed a Novice Area level or above summer competition in Dressage or Eventing in the current year or have done so in previous years, completed above Prelim level with British Dressage (or DI) or at BD Novice Team / My Quest, or been placed 1st – 4th on more than two occasions at a previous Preliminary PC70 Regional Championships.</li> <li>• Foundation PC70 Plus Dressage Test (Regional Championships): is solely for individuals – there is no team competition. Members must be aged 14 and over on 1st January of current year. Combination of horse and rider are not eligible if they have completed a Novice Area level or above summer competition in Dressage or Eventing in the current year or have done so in previous years, completed above Prelim level with British Dressage (or DI) or at BD Novice Team/My Quest, or been placed 1st – 4th on more than two occasions at a previous Preliminary PC70 Regional Championships.</li> <li>• Grassroots PC80 Dressage Test: the combination of horse and rider are not eligible if they have completed an Intermediate Area level or above summer competition in Dressage or Eventing in the current year or have done so in previous years, completed above Prelim level with British Dressage (or DI) at BD Novice Team / My Quest or been placed 1st-4th in the ride-off at previous Grassroots PC80 Regional Dressage Championships.</li> <li>• Novice Dressage Test: the combination of horse and rider are not eligible if they have completed an Open Area Level or above summer competition in Dressage in the current year or have done so in previous years, won any BD (or DI) points (BD Preliminary points do not count for the purposes of this rule), completed at BD (or DI) Elementary level or above (BD Team/My Quest competitions do not count for the purposes of this rule), or competed in BD Novice Music classes.</li> <li>• Intermediate Dressage Test: the combination of horse and rider are not eligible if they have won any BD (or DI) points at Elementary level or above, or completed at BD (or DI) Medium level or above (BD Team/My Quest competitions do not count for the purposes of this rule).</li> </ul>

# COMPETITION DETAILS & RULES

<b>Protests/ Objections</b>	Only the DC or their appointed representative are entitled to lodge protests/objections. Please refer to Rule 17 for detailed instructions including the requirement of a deposit of £50.
<b>Photographic Rights</b>	Competitors and their parents/guardians have given permission for any photographic and/or film or TV footage taken of persons or horses/ponies taking part in Pony Club events to be used and published in any media whatsoever for editorial purposes, press information or advertising by or on behalf of the Pony Club and/or Official Sponsors of the Pony Club.
<b>Equine Passport</b>	A valid passport and vaccination record must accompany the horse/pony to this event and must be available for inspection if required by event officials. Vaccinations must be in accordance with The Pony Club Equine Influenza Vaccination Rule ( <a href="https://resources.pcuk.org/wp-content/uploads/2024/08/The-Pony-Club-Equine-Influenza-VACCINATION-RULE.pdf">https://resources.pcuk.org/wp-content/uploads/2024/08/The-Pony-Club-Equine-Influenza-VACCINATION-RULE.pdf</a> ). Please check these rules carefully.
