## Tetrathlon

- Class 1: Beanies – 5 to 7 years mixed teams.**  
Bean bag throw; Run 500m; Swim 2 mins (flotation aids may be used – 50 point penalty)  
Cross country ride height 40cm approx. – (may be led or assisted – 50 penalties)  
Sec A: Girls      Sec B: Boys
- Class 2: Tadpoles – 9 years and under mixed teams.**  
Shoot, 2 handed static targets; Run 1000m; Swim 2 mins;  
Cross country ride height 60cm approx.  
Sec A: Girl      Sec B: Boys
- Class 3: Minimus – 11 years and under mixed teams**  
Shoot, 2 handed turning targets; Run 1000m; Swim 2 mins;  
Cross country ride height 75cm approx.  
Sec A: Girls      Sec B: Boys
- Class 4: Juniors - 14 years and under mixed teams**  
Shoot, 1 handed turning targets; Run 1500m; Swim 3 mins;  
Cross country ride height 90cm approx. (75cm course – 500pt penalty)  
**NOTE: The riding phase for Juniors will be held on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> April at Tidpit Down Hunter trial.**  
Sec A: Girls      Sec B: Boys

Competitors may jump the course below their own height but will incur 500 penalties.

## Triathlon

- Class 5: Beanies triathlon – 4 to 7 years mixed teams.**  
Bean bag throw; Run 500m; Swim 2 mins (flotation aids may be used – 50 point penalty)  
Sec A: Girls      Sec B: Boys
- Class 6: Tadpoles – 9 years and under mixed teams.**  
Shoot, 2 handed static targets; Run 1000m; Swim 2 mins;  
Sec A: Girls      Sec B: Boys
- Class 7: Minimus – 11 years and under mixed teams**  
Shoot, 2 handed turning targets; Run 1000m; Swim 2 mins;  
Sec A: Girls      Sec B: Boys

4. Results:

In a team of 4, the best overall 3 scores count

Queries:

Lodged by managers only and within 30 minutes after posting of provisional results and within 10 minutes of final results being posted.

5. Timings:

6. Shooting:

All guns are to be kept in a locked car boot other than at the shooting centre at time of shoot. Guns must remain boxed until the range steward gives the order to ‘unbox’ at the start of the detail and must be boxed again before the competitor leaves the firing point.

Eye protection must be worn when shooting and long trousers are required.

7. Riding:

All competitors to print own numbers and provide bibs

All riding hats to comply with the 2026 Pony Club hat rules.

Body protector Beta 2018 level 3 (blue and black label).

Spurs may only be worn by riders who have achieved the C+ riding test or the spurs achievement badge.

8. Dogs:

Please **DO NOT** bring dogs onto the Estate.

9. Legal liability:

Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

10. Health & Safety:

The Organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable care to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers, all officials and stewards.
