Each class will consist of two rounds. The PC90, PC80, PC70 will have two rounds with the second one being single phase. The PC110 and PC100 will have a third-round jump-off at the Judge's discretion. Please note that some rounds and/or classes will be on Dorset Show Ground's immaculate grass arena.

ENTRIES

Entries should be made **online** via **Entrymaster** and will open on 1st June and close on 26th June, 2026. These entries are subject to a non-refundable booking fee and include First Aid.

DCs to submit **number of expected entries** for their Branch in each class by 25th May, 2026, via email oiseaux99@hotmail.com.

DCs/Team Managers to submit **Teams** via Entrymaster by 4pm on 29th June, 2026.

Times will be published on www.ponyclubresults.co.uk by 6pm on 3rd July, 2026.

The Organisers reserve the right to limit a Branch to the number of teams entered in any one class should the entries exceed the limit.

ELIGIBILITY

Please ensure all members comply with 2026 eligibility as per the Show Jumping Rulebook 2026.

NUMBERS

Numbers to be printed off Pony Club Results.

We ask that you wear the official paper numbers as these classes have been generously sponsored and we would like to have the Sponsors name and logo on each competitor number.

We would also prefer **NOT to have bridle numbers** as they are not easy to read from a distance.

Riders must bring their own bibs.

SUBSTITUTIONS

After the closing date substitutions may only be made as per **Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2026**.

For **ALL** changes of horse and rider substitutions after the times have been published there is a £5 charge, please contact Emma Bird oiseaux99@hotmail.com.

WITHDRAWALS AND REFUNDS

If a Branch or Centre withdraws a Team or Individual prior to the entry closing date, a full refund of entry will be made less an administration charge.

Withdrawals after the closing date for a competition will not be refunded.

In the event of the competition being abandoned, for whatever reason, a refund of 50% of the entry will be given. In such an instance the refund process will be communicated and must be followed.

PRIZES, QUALIFIERS AND PRIZE GIVING

Prize giving times will be announced on the day.

All prize winners must be correctly dressed in their competition clothes.

ENTRY CONDITIONS

To be run in accordance with **Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2026**.

Rulebook for 2026 can be found at www.pcuk.org/pony-club-rule-books.

Tagged hats must be worn at all times (including prize-giving) when mounted with chinstrap fastened and adjusted so as to prevent movement of the hat in the event of a fall.

Please ensure you comply with **Rule 16 Dress in the Show Jumping Rulebook 2026**.

Spurs may not be worn by a Pony Club member at a Pony Club activity or event unless that member has passed either the **Pony Club C+ Riding Test or the Pony Club Spurs Test**.

Reasonable Adjustment Policy. This form must be submitted to the Secretary by **21st June, 2026**. If it is submitted after this date, there are no guarantees that the adjustment will be applied. This timeframe ensures that there is sufficient time for consideration of the application and that any adjustment that is agreed upon is fair and in place. [reasonable-adjustment-policy.pdf](#).

Competitors must present themselves to the steward for tack inspection 30-minutes before their allocated jumping time. Please ensure you comply with **Rule 17 Saddlery and Equipment in the Show Jumping Rulebook 2026**.

All working in for all classes, must be by competitor with a class entry on that pony.

Only District Commissioners or their appointed representatives are entitled to lodge protests or objections and will be managed as per **Rule 41 Protests or Objections in the Show Jumping Rulebook 2026** and will include the requirement of a deposit of £50. These objections must be reported to the **Secretary's office** and **NOT the Judges Box!**

A **valid passport and vaccination record** must accompany the horse/pony to this event, must be available for inspection if required by event officials and must be produced on request at any other time during the event. **All ponies/horses must be compliant with the current Pony Club minimum vaccination requirements** – please see the website for the current rule.

Photographic Rights – competitors and their parents/guardians have given permission for any photographic and/or film or TV footage taken of persons or horses/ponies taking part in Pony Club events to be used and published in any media whatsoever for editorial purposes, press information or advertising by or on behalf of the Pony Club and/or Official Sponsors of the Pony Club.

LEGAL LIABILITY

Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. **Entries are only accepted on this basis.**
