RULES OF THE SHOW

- 1 The Judge's decision is final
- 2 Hats to approved Pony Club standard must be worn at all times when mounted.
- 3 No galloping on the field

- 4 Dogs to be kept on leads when on the show field
- 5 In classes where age restrictions apply, a competitor's age is as on the show day
- 6 No horse to compete in more than 3 show jumping classes

RULES OF THE SHOW *(continued)*

- 7 **Health, Safety and Welfare:** The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the Officials and Stewards.
- 8 **Legal Liability:** Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

From Tavistock

From Tavistock town centre (The Square) take the Brentor road up the hill (Drake Road, Butcher Park Hill). After 2.3 miles turn left at Pitland corner (signposted to Chillaton). Head straight on for 2 miles to Iron Railings crossroads where you turn left. At the next crossroads, Longcross, the field entrance is then on your left on the junction.

From the A30 Launceston or Okehampton

Turn off the A30 at Lifton and follow the A388 road past Lifton Farm Shop and continue through the village.. Just past the Fox and Grapes pub turn RIGHT signposted to Chillaton. After 1.8 miles turn left signposted Chillaton & Tavistock.

At the T junction in Chillaton turn right up the hill and after about 1.2 miles turn RIGHT signposted to Lamerton and Milton Abbot. **After about half a mile** you will reach Long Cross Crossroads where the field will then be found on your right.

NB: No dogs PLEASE! at the request of the landowner
