Combination of horse and riders are NOT eligible if they have: • Completed at PC80 or above in any Spring Festival or summer Show Jumping or Summer Eventing Area Competitions or Championships in any previous year • Previously completed in a BS competition with a starting height of 80cm or over	70cm	2

5	PC80 Regional Championship Qualifier For Teams and Individuals 2 rounds, 2 nd round timed. Combination of Horse and Rider are NOT eligible if they have: • Previously completed at PC90 and above in any Spring Festival or summer Show Jumping or Eventing Area Competitions or Championships • Previously ever finished 1st to 3rd as an individual in the Show Jumping or Eventing at a Regional Championships on two occasions. • Previously completed in any BS competition with a starting height of 90 or above	80cm	2
6	OPEN 90cm Single phase	90cm	1
7	PC90 Championship Qualifier For Teams and Individuals. 2 rounds, with jump off round if tied. Combination of Horse and Rider are NOT eligible if they have: • completed a PC110 Area Level or above competition in previous years • previously ever finished 1st to 3rd as an individual at the Pony Club Championships at PC90 level or above on two occasions • Previously placed 1st to 6th at a PC100 Spring Festival or summer Area Competition or Championships	90cm	1

9	PC100 Championship Qualifier For Teams and Individuals. 2 rounds, with jump off round if tied. Combination of Horse and Rider are NOT eligible if they have: Previously ever finished 1st to 3rd as an individual at the PC Championships at PC100 or above on 2 occasions	100cm	1

Combination of horse and rider can compete at two adjacent levels of the same sport at the Area Competition or at the Championships, apart from PC80 and PC90 ie. combinations can compete at PC70 & PC80, PC90& PC100 or PC100 & PC110. No horse or pony may compete in more than 2 classes

No horse may be ridden more than once at the same level in any one year in any of the qualifying competitions or at the Show Jumping Championships

Tack and Turnout: There will be an individual and team turnout completion for all qualifying classes, run in accordance with the Show jumping Rulebook 2024.

Horsemanship Award: This will be run for riders competing in PC100 and PC110 classes and run in accordance with the Show Jumping Rulebook 2024.

Rosettes to 6th place individuals, and 6 place for teams.

Entries: All entries must be made online using www.horse-events.co.uk Pony Club membership numbers and Branch/Centre names are needed to enter a qualifying class - the DC or SJ Team organiser should validate entries before entering. Horse and rider changes before the closing date can be made online by logging into your Horse Events account and editing your entry under 'my booking' tab. If you need to cancel an entry or change a class before the closing date please email info@horse-events.co.uk

Substitutions: After the closing date substitutions may only be made as per the PC Show Jumping Rules 2024. Please email any changes after the closing date to western@pcuk.org

Withdrawals & Refunds: Full refunds will be given up until the closing date of the competition Monday 24th June 2024. After the closing date no refunds will

be made without a Doctor's or Vet's certificate produced no later than 24 hours after the event. If produced after this no refunds will be given. In the event of cancellation, full refund less the booking fee and £1 admin cost. <u>All entries subject to a non-refundable booking fee.</u>

Entry to be run in accordance with Pony Club Show jumping Rules 2024 Please ensure your members comply with current eligibility, hat tagging, body protector and have a responsible adult present.

- Please print your own paper numbers and these must always be visible when mounted.
- Late entries may be accepted at the organiser's discretion.
- Queries may only be raised via the Secretary/Organiser by the DC or their appointee. Protests / objections will be managed as per Rule 41 (Show Jumping Rule Book).
- Photographic Rights competitors and their parents/guardians have given permission for any photographic and/or film or TV footage taken of persons or horses/ponies taking part in Pony Club events to be used and published in any media whatsoever for editorial purposes, press information or advertising by or on behalf of the Pony Club and/or Official Sponsors of the Pony Club.
- •A valid passport and vaccination record must accompany the horse/pony to this event and must be available for inspection if required by event officials.
