The Ride Phase for those doing 60 cms and above will be cross country. The 60 cms will be a shortened cross country course. The 40 cms will be show jumps in an enclosed grass arena. In all classes competitors can take the option to ride a smaller course. There will be a 30 cms show jumping course for Beanies to have this option.

There is no restriction on number of heights you can drop down. Each height will incur a penalty of 200 points - one height down 200 or 400 points for 2 down and so on. Please state when you enter if you intend to do this. We will accept changes up or down if declared early on Sunday.

Beanies and those jumping down to the 40 cms height may be assisted (but NO lead reins). Those doing 30 cms **only** may be on lead reins.

Rosettes: Individuals and teams to 6th place.

Medals for the best performance in each triathlon phase and rosettes for all clear rounds.

Teams: Tri and/or Tet teams of four (three to count) chosen from **ANY** classes but all teams must be from the same club. Teams for Triathlon must be declared before start of shooting.

Geriathlon competitors in the Triathlon can if they wish combine with different people taking one or two phases each. Those doing ride phase must have also competed in at least one Triathlon phase. They can jump down to any height with penalties.

Entries: Entries via horse-events. CLOSING DATE Sunday 7th September

Those entering the Tetrathlon will also be in the Triathlon.

- The judges' decision is final. The competition will be run under **Pony Club Tetrathlon Rules** 2025.
- We are very lucky to have the use of the lovely course at Trebudannon belonging to the Four Burrow Hunt and only usually available in September for their own events.
- All ages to be calculated as on 1st January 2025. Members who have attained their 8th birthday may enter classes 6,7 or 8. Competitors in class 9 must be under 8 as on the 1st January 2025.
- Times are approximate and will depend on the number of entries. Exact times will be posted on our website and www.ponyclubresults and sent to team managers after close of entries.
- Guns must be flagged and kept in cases and only removed on the instruction of the shooting steward.
- Please bring clean trainers for entry into the sports hall for the shooting phase. All shoes MUST be removed before entry to the swimming pool.
- There is only one outside lane at the pool so if too many requested youngest competitors will have priority. **Buoyancy aids only allowed without penalty in Beanies.**
- The running phase will be organised with the group start. Running will be on a running track
- Further information will be posted on pony clubresults and sent with times.
- In the event of a tie in the Tetrathlon the points in the riding phase will decide the final placing.
- The Carn Brea Café will be open on the Saturday. There will be catering at the ride on Sunday.
- Please print your own number bibs for the ride phase.
