• The competition will be run as far as possible in accordance with The Pony Club Tetrathlon Rules 2025

- Any objections must be put forward by the Team Trainer.
- The judge's decision will be final
- Shooting: Please ensure all competitors comply with firearms regulations. It is a condition of entry that all competitors can handle a gun correctly and that they and their loaders have had adequate training in safety on the firing range. Pistols must be kept boxed at all times. They may only be unboxed at the firing point on the instruction of the Range Steward. You are reminded of the rules regarding dress and please bring clean trainers for entry into the sports hall.
- Running: All competitors in Classes 1 9 will be running in heats.
- Swimming: If you intend to Dive rather than start in the Pool, you must show your Dive Certificate to the Steward at the start of the Swimming Phase. Please ensure that all competitors do not bring muddy shoes into the Helston Swimming Pool complex and that no footwear is worn in the swimming area.

Buoyancy aids will be allowed in Class 1 only, with no penalties.

PLEASE INDICATE ON THE ENTRY FORM IF THE COMPETITOR IS IN GENUINE NEED OF AN OUTSIDE LANE.

- Times are approximate and will depend on the number of entries. Exact times will be sent to Team Trainers after close of entries.
- The adult class is very informal please encourage more parents and supporters to have a go.
