riding boots and jodhpurs MUST BE WORN. The tack checkers reserve the right to deny the wearing of any fancy dress that they deem unsafe. Competitors do not need to wear show jackets, shirts or ties, but long sleeves must be worn, hair tied back, no jewellery and strictly NO CAPES & NO HOODS.

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. All persons entering the site shall be bound by these Rules and Conditions of Entry.
- 2. The judges decision is final.
- 3. The Organisers reserve the right to alter any part of the schedule or to refuse entries without stating the reasons.
- 4. In the event of cancellation, entry fees will be returned, less an administration fee of £2 per competitor, to offset costs.

- 6. Any objection should be made, to the secretary, in the 30 minute window of the results being published and the results being finalised. Any objections after this time will not be considered.
- 7. Withdrawals £2 admin fee will be deducted from any refunds made before the closing date. No refunds will be made after the closing date unless a medical or veterinary certificate is provided within 1 week of the event. (Subject to notification of withdrawal prior to the event, and less £2 admin fee).
- 8. Securely fastened hard hats must be worn at all times by everyone when mounted. Hats should be tagged and must conform to Pony Club Rules 2025. All hats to be checked in warm up area prior to entering the arena.
- 9. Body protectors (if worn) must comply with the new 2024 rule BETA 2018 Level 3 standard (blue and black label).
- 10. The spur rules will be strictly followed. Competitors wishing to wear spurs must have the relevant hat tag, or corresponding badge felt.
- 11. No horse or pony may be ridden in more than 2 classes.
- 12. Horses and ponies must be over 4 years old on the day of the competition.
- 13. No galloping anywhere on the site. Riders must only walk their horses / ponies in the car park.
- 14. No lungeing anywhere on the site.
- 15. Dogs must be on a lead AT ALL TIMES.
- 16. Legal Liability: save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
- 17. Health and Safety: Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.
- 18. Privacy Notice: Please note that we will be publishing the competitors' times and results on the 'Pony Club Results' website. This will include competitors' name, horse name, branch and full results. If you wish your details to be excluded from this please make a note of this on your entry form.
