CLASS 1 – JUNIOR/SENIOR

Teams of four – must have two junior members (ages to be 14 and under on the 1st January 2026) and two members of any age up to 25

CLASS 2 – MINIS

Teams of four – Ages to be 10 years and under on the 1st January 2026 with one member to be 8 years and under on the 1st January 2026

**** All teams can be made up with one member only who has also competed at another level in this year's competition provided they are eligible. Complete teams may not compete at more than one level.**

****The Pony Club would prefer teams of four however they will accept teams of three at both the Qualifier and the Final if you are unable to get a fourth member. If you have a team of three, the members must include the following:**

Minis – Ages to be 10 years and under on the 1st January 2026 with one member that must be 8 years and under on the 1st January 2026

Juniors/Seniors – Must have one member to be aged 14 years and under on the 1st January 2026 and the other two can be any age up to 25.

**Area teams can be made up if Karen Harris our Pony Club Area Representative is contacted. These can be members from Branches or Centres but not a mix of both to make up an Area team who would also be eligible to qualify for the Championships.
