NOTES

- ON ARRIVAL: A 'pack' will be labelled per Club and in the entrance hall of the Sports Hall. Please can the Team Manager collect the 'pack' and distribute to their members accordingly to include all targets.
- SHOOTING: Will be carried out in the Sports Hall. Guns must be flagged. Please ensure competitors and loaders are deemed safe and competent. **Please indicate on the entry if the competitor is left handed or sharing a gun with another competitor.**
- BEAN BAG: Will be in the Sports Hall in a separate room to the shooting. The target will be flat
- RUNNING: This will be on grass on the playing fields on varied terrain and chance of getting a little muddy!! We will run heats with mass starts. Competitor number to be clearly written on the hand or arm.
- SWIMMING: Dive certificates must have been sent to the organizer prior to the event if you wish to dive – dc.tetcottsouthtetcotts@pcuk.org. No spectators will be allowed poolside. Warmups will be in designated competition lanes only at the times given on Pony Club Results. Buoyancy aids will be allowed without penalties in class 8. **Please indicate on the entry form if an outside lane is in genuine need.**

RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- All persons entering the site shall be bound by these Rules and Conditions of Entry
- The judge's decision is final. The competition will be run under Pony Club Tetrathlon Rules 2026.
- In the event of a query, please complete a query form which will be obtainable from the Organizers on the day who will then discuss this with the Official Steward with the intention of resolving all queries on the day of the competition.
- Times given are approximate and will depend on the number of entries. Exact times will be posted on Thursday 5th February not before 19.00 on www.ponyclubresults.co.uk.
- You must be a member of the Pony Club to compete.
- The Organizers reserve the right to alter any part of the schedule or to refuse entries without stating the reasons.
- In the event of cancellation, entry fees will be refunded less the booking fee.
- Withdrawals – A full refund prior to the closing date will be given less the booking fee. After the closing date, there will be no refunds.
- Dogs must be on a lead AT ALL TIMES and are not permitted inside any buildings. They must be cleared up after **AND ALL WASTE TO BE TAKEN HOME – NOT PUT IN THE BINS ONSITE.**
