Rules

1. The hunter trial will be run in accordance with the current Pony Club Eventing Rules. Please go to http://www.pcuk.org/index.php/dcs_information/rule_books for details.
2. The committee cannot be held responsible for any damage, loss or injury to persons, horses or property.
3. The decisions of the committee and judges are final.
4. **Riding hats and body protectors complying with current Pony Club Eventing Rules, and footwear with heels, must be worn. Hats and body protectors will be checked when tack is inspected and entrants with non-compliant equipment will not be able to compete. Number bibs are required for all classes and medical armbands are advised. Tack checks may be carried out prior to competing. the secretary on the day will give out hat tags if needed.**
5. Correct PC/competition dress to be worn at mounted/unmounted prize giving
6. Numbers MUST be printed, and a clear number bib worn.
7. All horses/ponies to be at least 5 years old.
8. **Non-Pony Club members are not covered by the Pony Club insurance policy. Every competitor must either be a member of the Pony Club or have third party liability insurance and be able to show evidence of such insurance if asked.**
9. **Any unsafe behaviour or behaviour deemed detrimental to a horse or pony's welfare (e.g. excessive use of the whip or spurs) may at the organisers' discretion result in the competitor being asked to leave the course.** Please read the Ponyclub 2026 rules on whips and spurs for competition.
10. Objections must be lodged in writing with a £10 deposit, to the secretary within 10 minutes of the results being published.
11. No entry fee will be refunded after the closing date for entries.
12. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
