2. Pony Club Dressage Rules 2019 and Dengie Dressage rules 2018/19 will apply. ..Please view Pony Club web for 2019 Hat Rules, Body Protector Rule 2019 and S.J Rules
3. Commanders are NOT permitted in class 4, 5 or 6.
5. Qualifiers from class1, 2 & 3 will be allowed to enter class 4, 5 & 6 on the day.
6. This show is open to all but any individual entering who is not a current member of the pony club must have adequate 3rd party and personal insurance, e.g. BHS gold membership, riding club membership.
7. Objections must be made in writing, accompanied by a £20 deposit to be refunded if the objection is upheld.
8. The organisers reserve the right to refuse or restrict entries.
9. In the event of cancellation due to adverse weather conditions, entry fees will be returned less £2 for administration.
10. Competitors may withdraw from a class at any time but withdrawals after the closing date will not be refunded.
