Forthcoming Championship dates

Regional class is the Area Qualifier for the Regional Pony Club Championships being held at Ian Stark Equestrian Centre on 9 to 11 August.

Novice, Open Novice, Intermediate and Open classes are all Area Qualifier classes for the Pony Club Championships being held at Cholmondeley Castle on 16th to 20th August.

In all classes, team members are automatically included in the individual competition.

Entries

- Entries are restricted to 200 competitors on the day. Please get your entries in as soon as possible.
- Closing Date for all competitions: 19th June. Late entries will be accepted up to 24 June if space permits with a £15 surcharge.

- Times available from www.equoevents.co.uk on Sunday 30 June.
- In the event of a cancellation due to weather an admin charge of £10/horse will be retained.
- If a competitor cancels before entry closing date refunds can be arranged.

Stabling

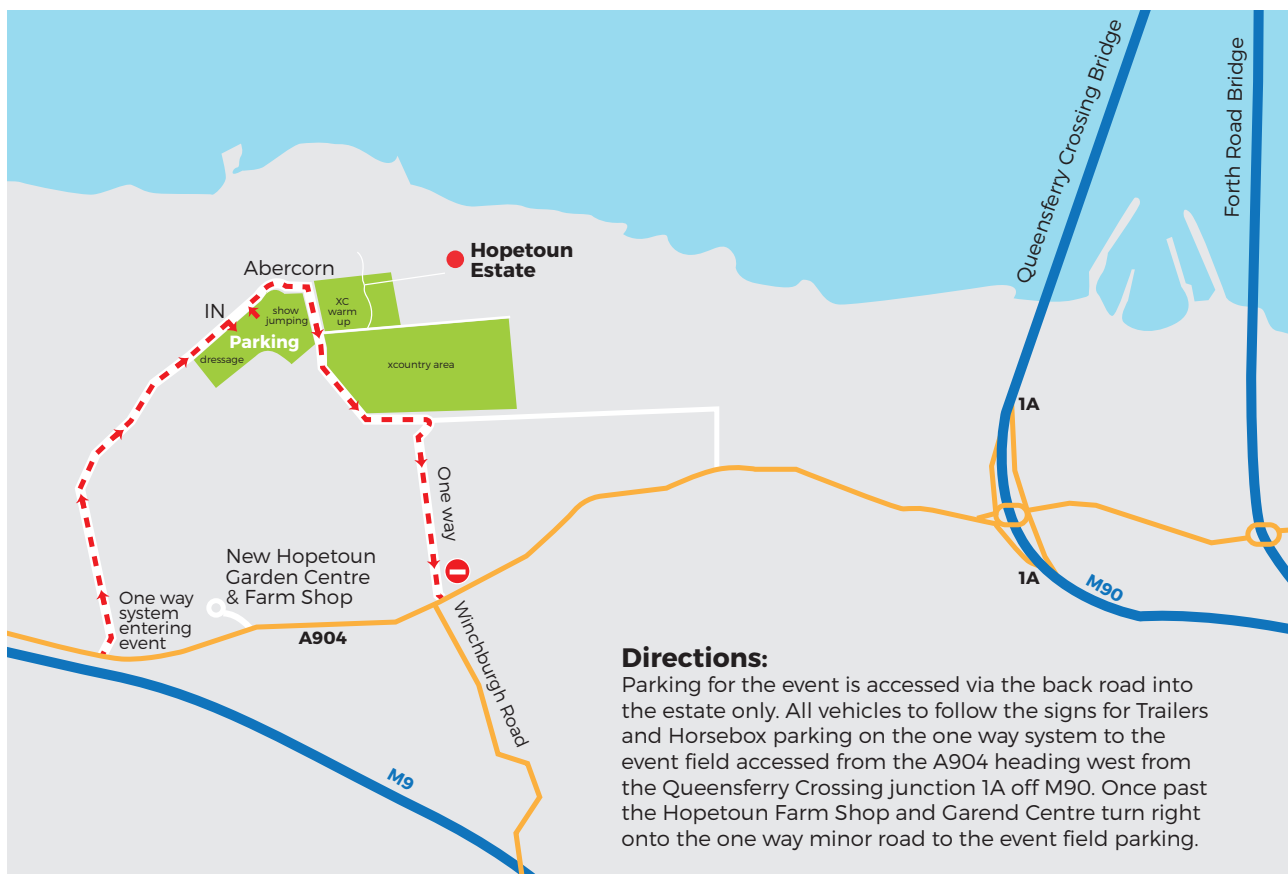

Please Note

- Competitor numbers for your bib can be collected by the Team Trainer / representative from the Secretary's Tent
- All hats must have an official current Pony Club tag – if required bring the hat to the Secretary's Tent along with your horses passport as Pony Club 2019 vaccination rules will apply.
- All competitors **must** report to the Secretary's tent at their allocated time for a brief on their duty. Teams/ individuals will be eliminated if they don't help with a short volunteering role during the day.
- Body protectors and a medical armband must be worn for the XC phase. Please remember new PC Body Protector Rules.
- Tack Inspection: all competitors must have a tack check before warming-up in each discipline.
- Prize giving dismounted and properly dressed in front of the Main Tent.
- Hot and cold catering available on the field.
- Dogs **only on leads** allowed within the lorry park area. No dogs allowed outside this area. This rule applies to course walk day too due to Deer in the park
- If a competitor is wearing a Point 2 Air Jacket, please bring your own number bib and print off your own number and register with the Secretary.
- Sinclair Photography will be taking photos at the event which may appear on our website or be published in an equestrian magazines – **please indicate on the entry if any competitor wishes not to have photographs published.**

Directions:

Parking for the event is accessed via the back road into the estate only. All vehicles to follow the signs for Trailers and Horsebox parking on the one way system to the event field accessed from the A904 heading west from the Queensferry Crossing junction 1A off M90. Once past the Hopetoun Farm Shop and Garend Centre turn right onto the one way minor road to the event field parking.
