Class 5: Junior

Open to members aged 12 and under as at 1st January 2019. Not to have competed at Senior SJ (interbranch). Ponies only, max 14.2hh. Also, not to have competed at Senior SJ (interbranch) in the current year. No JA ponies that have been registered with BS in the last 2 years. Max height of fences in the 2nd round 0.70m. For both rounds the best 3 scores for each team will count. Second round will be against the clock.

RULES

2019 Pony Club SJ rules apply.

Pony Club Vaccination Rules Apply.

Branches may enter a maximum of 2 teams and 2 individuals, however 'B' teams may have to be balloted out if competition is oversubscribed.

Each team is to consist of 3 or 4 riders; the best 3 scores to count.

Teams must be represented by a team manager who will be responsible for team members being ready to compete on time.

Competitor numbers can be collected by the team manager from the Secretary.

The manager must declare changes before the start of the class and teams **must** report for the first round to the Tack Check Judge **at least** 30 minutes before their start time.

All team members jump in rounds 1 and 2. In both rounds, all 4 members jump in the order declared on entry form.

Any objections must be made in writing by the team manager and be accompanied by a £10 deposit which will only be refunded if the objection is upheld.
