Classes 3 and 8 one round, timed, each jump worth its number in points and joker worth 20 points if jumped clear. 20 points lost if joker knocked down.

**ADDITIONAL COVID REGULATIONS**

We will not be able to accept entries from competitors in tier 3 or Scotland as it stands on 1/12/20 (if guidelines change nearer the time, we will be happy to take your entries)

Only one support person plus named competitor on the day for each horse, with full details on entry form to aide track and trace systems.

Please bring your own hand sanitisers and masks these will be required around the secretary's area and walking the course.

Anyone seen to be flouting social distancing rules will be asked to leave the premises by the organisers. Please bring hand sanitisers with you and apply regularly. If you have any symptoms of COVID 19 please do not attend.

No one is allowed in the warm up arena to alter jumps. All necessary jumps will be set out at the correct height for the class by a steward. Please listen to the ring steward who will call you forward at your time. No more than 6 competitors in the warm up area at one time.

Where first aid attention is given to a rider or visitor, the first aider will where possible maintain social distancing and wearing PPE.

Please keep 1m plus away from anyone outside you bubble and park 5m away from each other.

Please arrive, compete and if you haven't done well please leave. Results will be announced after each class and prizes collected from the secretary area which will clearly signed with social distancing measures in place on the day. If competitors have left these will be posted on after the event.

NO takeaway food or drinks will be available

## Regulations

All persons entering, competing or otherwise taking part in these classes shall be considered as having read and accepted the following regulations:-

- Classes will be judged in accordance with Pony Club rules or as specified.
- Competitors should be appropriately turned out.
- The Judges decision is final.
- The Cumberland Farmers North Branch of the Pony Club reserve the right to add/remove classes from the schedule.
- Riding Hats must be properly secured and be up to the current Pony Club standard with the relevant kite mark.
- Spur rule applies to Pony Club members.

- A competitor may be disqualified at any stage and future entries may be refused:
  - a) for dangerous riding
  - b) for misuse of whip or spur or ill-treatment of the horse
  - c) if the horse is lame, sick or exhausted
  - d) for unseemly behaviour, including bad language
- Objections must be lodged within 10 minutes of the results being posted. Any objection must be accompanied by £10 which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
