- Class 1 50cm - 9 years and under. **Individual** only competition
- Class 2 60cm - 9 years and under
- Class 3 PC70 – 13 years and under
- Class 4 PC80 - any age
- Class 5 PC90 – any age
- Class 6 PC100- any age

Max heights are as above for Section A with a maximum increase of 10cm in Section B.

Closing date for entries- Wednesday 27th November

Late entries will not be allowed.

1. All Classes to be run under [Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2024](#) over a single-phase course divided into two sections – section A, over 5 to 7 obstacles, to be untimed or time allowed; section B, over 5 to 7 obstacles, to be timed. **Maximum 12 obstacles in total.**
2. Winter League classes will run in accordance with Area 5 Winter League Rules to accommodate WL and non-WL teams and individuals with appropriate course changes where necessary. Points will be awarded in accordance with the Area 5 Winter League Rules
3. Branches entering more than one team in any one class must name all teams and clearly identify their Winter League Team.

In all Pony Club Show Jumping, excessive use of the whip, including repeated slapping down the shoulder, is prohibited.

The rules state that the whip may be used a maximum of three times during any round.
