Rules:

Classes will be split if there are enough entries.

The Novice class is for those who haven't competed at Junior level or above and need an introductory level of competition. Established riders may enter this class HC only.

The showjumping will start with the 40cm track. Additional rides will be at the end of each height class.

Requests for Reasonable Adjustment must be submitted before 16th Oct 2025.

Competitors may jump a lower course if they wish, but will incur **500 penalties** for each level they drop down. Anyone wishing to jump a lower course please notify the secretary by 6pm on Wednesday 29 October.

Competitors may be led, but will incur 300 penalties

Competitors may have a supporter in the arena but beyond touching distance. This will incur **150 penalties**

Entries:

Entries to be made online to Entry Master

All entries are subject to a non-refundable booking fee as stated online.

Except for Wrinklies you will need your Pony Club membership number and Branch/Centre name to enter.

Changes, Late Entries, Withdrawals & Refunds:

For horse and rider changes email the event secretary at area5tetrathlon@outlook.com. After the closing date late entry requests may be accepted at the organiser's discretion (surcharge £5).

Full refunds will be given up until 6pm on Wednesday 29 October. After this no refunds will be given.

In the event of cancellation/abandonment 80% of the Entry Fee will be refunded.

Results & Prizes:

Scores will be available online at www.ponyclubresults.co.uk.

Rosettes to 6th place in each class. Medal for best shoot and run in each class.

Dress code for prize giving is Branch Sweatshirts.

Pony Club Teams:

Teams to be notified to the Event Secretary by the Team Manager before Monday 27 October 2025.

Branch teams of 3 or 4 competitors from any Triathlon or Biathlon class except class 6. Best 3 scores to count. Rosettes to 6th.

Entry Conditions:

GENERAL

Queries during the competition to be raised in writing with the Events Secretary, Penny Wingfield, by the Team Manager or DC of the Branch.

SHOOTING

Protective or prescription glasses are COMPULSORY.

Long trousers must be worn. Shoes must not cover the ankle.

Guns must be kept in their cases until the Range Conducting Officer gives the order to "unbox" them at the start of a detail, and must be "boxed" again before the competitor leaves the firing point. At all other times guns must be stored in their boxes and kept in a secure place. Pellets are to be kept separately from the gun box, ideally in a tin in a plastic bag labelled with your name.

All guns to be fitted with a safety flag at all times except when authorized by the Range Conducting Officer.

No person under 18 years of age may be responsible for, or carry a gun.

Competitors are reminded to check that their guns function correctly and have enough charge before arriving at the competition.

Competitors and their parents must familiarize themselves with the rules around shooting as detailed in The Rulebook.

RUNNING

The run will be on grass and competitors will start at 1 minute intervals.

RIDING

Tetrathlon Arena Jumping rules apply. There will be up to two Tetrathlon type obstacles serving as gate and slipway (tbc). The courses are not timed.

The riding is in an outdoor arena on an artificial surface.

A horse may be shared by two members of the same family. No horse may do more than four rounds during the day.

Competitors are to provide their own numbers for riding and running and to ensure they are clearly visible and easily read.

Riding hats are required and must comply with Rule 17. All hats must be tagged to show that they are compliant before being brought to the competition.

Body protectors are optional as the riding is show jumping.

Stirrups with enhanced grip features, stirrups which connect the boot and the stirrup magnetically, or interlocking boot soles and stirrup Treads are not allowed.

If a whip is carried it must comply with Rule 17m and only be used in accordance with that rule. Principally this means only for a good reason, at an appropriate time and no more than twice for any incident.

It is the parents' responsibility to ensure that rider equipment and pony tack are safe and comply with Rules 17 and 18.

A valid passport and vaccination record must accompany the horse/pony to this event and must be available for inspection if required by event officials. Vaccinations must be in accordance with Rule 21. No horse or pony may compete on the same day as a relevant injection is given or on any of the 6 days following such an injection.

Photographic Rights:

Photographic Rights – by entering this competition competitors and their guardians give permission for any photographic and/or film or TV footage taken of persons taking part in this event to be used and published in any media whatsoever for editorial purposes, press information or advertising by or on behalf of the Pony Club and/or Official Sponsors of the Pony Club.

Legal Liability:

Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or their tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

Health & Safety:

Organisers of this event take reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.
