COURSE WALK FOR CLASS 1 WILL COMMENCE AT 8.30 AM FOR 9.00 AM START

RULES

- This competition is run under Pony Club Rules 2025 (the Rules) and you are reminded that no jewellery is allowed. All tack and rider's clothing must comply with the Rules.
- There will be a Safety Tack Check before competitors will be allowed to compete but it is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that all stitching is safe.
- Hats of the accepted Pony Club standard 2025 must be worn at all times when mounted.
- All PC members must have their hats tagged.
- There will be one person (appointed by Albrighton Hunt) on foot in the collecting ring, managing entry and adjusting the practice fences. Other than riders, no one else will be permitted in the warm-up area. Riders will be limited to 6 in the warm-up area at any one time.
- All horse and ponies must be vaccinated and such vaccinations comply with the current Pony Club rules.
- All Classes are for teams of 3 or 4. The best 3 team scores will count. All competitors will jump two phases, the second phase will be timed. Individuals may enter and will be put into teams. Team members will also be judged as individuals.
- Horses/ponies may only compete once in a class and in a maximum of 3 classes.
- All new members and their ponies must have attended at least one working rally prior to the competition.
- Any objections must be lodged with £20 within 15 minutes of the occurrence. This will only be returned if the objection is upheld. The judges' decision is final.
- **Legal liability** – save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organiser of this event to which the Pony Club Rules 2025 apply, nor the Pony Club, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horse, owner, riders, spectators, land or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.
- **Health and safety** – the organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.
- The organisers reserve the right to alter, amend or cancel any class and to refuse any entry without any reason.
- **Dogs are not permitted in the arena or the parking area.**
- Please refrain from dropping litter and use the bins provided or take it home with you.
