There will be rosettes to 6th place in all classes and a trophy for the highest placed North Shropshire Member in 3 age categories (under 12 years, 12-15 years, 16 years and over).

The course will be open for walking from 2pm on Saturday 19th July.

Martha Lily Photography will be in capturing the action and there will be a catering van in attendance. Moreton Wood Forge Farrier and Severn Edge Vet will be in attendance. If you require their services on the day, please arrange payment directly with them.

Rules

1. The hunter trial will be run in accordance with the current Pony Club Eventing Rules. Please go to http://www.pcuk.org/index.php/dcs_information/rule_books for details.
2. The committee cannot be held responsible for any damage, loss or injury to persons, horses or property.
3. The decisions of the committee and judges are final.
4. Riding hats and body protectors complying with current Pony Club Eventing Rules must be worn. Tack checks will be carried out prior to competing.



5. Print off your number from Pony Club Results and display it in a number bib.
6. All horses/ponies to be at least 5 years old.
7. Non-Pony Club members are not covered by the Pony Club insurance policy. Every competitor must either be a member of the Pony Club or have third party liability insurance and be able to show evidence of such insurance if asked.
8. Pony club members can only wear spurs if the rider has the Pony Club yellow spurs hat tag.
9. No dogs permitted.
10. Horses must be vaccinated in accordance with pony club rules and passports must be available for spot checks.
11. Any unsafe behaviour or behaviour deemed detrimental to a horse or pony's welfare (e.g. excessive use of the whip or spurs) may at the organisers' discretion result in the competitor being asked to leave the course.
12. Objections must be lodged in writing with a £10 deposit, to the secretary within 10 minutes of the results being published on Pony Club Results
13. No entry fee will be refunded after the closing date for entries.
