1	Open & Intermediate Boys	shoot 10m, swim 4 mins, run 3000m
2	Open & Intermediate Girls	shoot 10m, swim 3 mins, run 1500m
3	Junior Boys (under 15)	shoot 7m, swim 3 mins, run 1500m
4	Junior Girls (under 15)	shoot 7m, swim 3 mins, run 1500m
5	Mini Boys * (Under 12)	shoot (2 hands, turning targets) 7m, swim 2 mins, run 1000m
6	Mini Girls * (Under 12)	shoot (2 hands, turning targets) 7m, swim 2 mins, run 1000m

• Competitors in classes 5 and 6 must be 8 years or over on 3rd January 2026

Non-qualifying Classes

7	Tadpole Boys** (under 10)	shoot (2 hands static targets) 7m, swim 2 mins, run 1000m
8	Tadpole Girls** (under 10)	shoot (2 hands static targets) 7m, swim 2 mins, run 1000m
9	Beanies Boys	Beanbag throw, swim 2 mins, run 500m
10	Beanies Girls	Beanbag throw, swim 2 mins, run 500m
11	Beanies Biathlon	Beanbag throw and run 500m

Note – for those wishing to dive, dive certificates must be submitted at the time of entry.

** Competitors in Classes 7 and 8 must be 8 years old or over on 3rd January 2026

Competitors in classes 9, 10 and 11 must be under 8 years old on 3rd January 2026

Teams of 3 or 4 members with the best 3 overall scores to count.

ROSETTES – to the first 6 individuals in each class and medals to each phase winner.

RULES

- 1. The competition will be run in accordance with the 2025 Tetrathlon Rule book. Please make sure you are familiar with the rules, especially those applying to gun laws.
- 2. All competitors to be members of the Pony Club.
- 3. Ages as at 1st January 2026 except where otherwise indicated.
- 4. Guns to be cased at all times until instructed by the range officer to un-box them at the start of the detail. At all other times guns must be stored in their boxes and locked in a secure place out of sight. Anyone loading a gun for a competitor must be over 18. No guns or pellets to be carried by anyone under 18, unless they are under the supervision of a person over 21 years old. It is <u>required</u> to wear long trousers. Substantial shoes (that cover the whole foot, but NOT up to or over the ankle bone) must be worn. <u>Any range staff</u> can order the STOP, STOP, STOP command if there is a potential or actual safety breach
- 5. Rule 36i: Please make sure you are familiar with the safety flag rule for all guns. This rule has been in operation since the start of 2022.
- 6. Swim diving certificates must be submitted at the time of entry. Without the relevant diving certificate (please see pony club rule book) competitors will not be able to dive from a block or from the side.
- 7. The decision of the organisers and judges is final. Complaints should be made by Team Managers only and within 20 minutes of the results being published.
- 8. No dogs are to be brought to the competition.
- 9. Do not at any time contact Cheslyn Hay regarding this competition we are hiring the venue only.
- 10. Please remove all muddy shoes upon entering any sports hall. No outdoor shoes to be worn pool side.
- 11. Please respect the property and grounds of the venue at all times.

Health & Safety - Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present.
