

TWO PHASE COMPETITION

FIRST PHASE – SHOW JUMPING

Speed 325mpm with time allowed Approx. 9 fences

Knock down	5 penalties
First refusal	5 penalties
Second refusal	10 penalties
Third refusal	Elimination
Fall of horse or rider	Elimination
Exceeding time allowed	Elimination

SECOND PHASE – CROSS COUNTRY

Speed 350mpm with a 10 second time window Approx. 9 fences

First refusal	20 penalties
Second refusal	40 penalties
Third refusal	Elimination
Fall of horse or rider	Elimination
There will be an optimum time in this section with a 10 second window Any time UNDER optimum – 1 penalty per sec Any time OVER optimum - 1 penalty per sec above the 10 second window	
Time penalties will not be incurred within the 10 second window but the ranking will be decided on those with ZERO penalties closest to the optimum time
