3	Mini Boys	11 years and under	7m, turning targets, two handed	Max 70cm (2'3")	1000m
4	Mini Girls	11 years and under	7m, turning targets, two handed	Max 70cm (2'3")	1000m
5	Tadpole Boys and Girls	9 years and under (Min. 8 years on the day)	7m, static targets, two handed	Max 60cm (2')	1000m
6	Beanies Boys and Girls	7 years and under	Bean Bag (Min. 3m throw)	Max 40cm (1'3") enclosed arena	500m

Teams of 3 or 4, teams may be mixed for Tadpoles and Beanies, the best 3 scores to count.

TIMES

Times and instructions will be emailed to Team Managers.

AWARDS

There will be rosettes for 1 - 6th placed teams and individuals, and medals for best shoot and best run in each class. Rosette to highest placed Berkeley Hunt Pony Club member in each class.

RIDING

If anyone wishes to jump a course below their class, they should notify the organiser IMMEDIATELY after the course walk of their class. Notification must be before the first rider of the class.

Competitors who jump the course below their own will incur 500 penalties.
Competitors may be led in Class 6 (Beanies) but will incur 400 penalties.
Competitors may be led in Class 5 (Tadpoles) but will incur 400 penalties.

JOCKEY SKULL caps must be worn when mounted at all times with the chinstrap fastened. They must bear the CE mark and quality symbol, either BS kitemark PAS 015:1998 or 2011, the official SNELL E2001 onwards label or the SEI global symbol.

All hats must carry a Pony Club, British Eventing or British Riding Club AQUAMARINE tag.

It is compulsory that body protectors are worn by all competitors, to meet BETA 2009 Level 3 standard (purple label) or BETA 2018 Level 3 standard (blue and black label).

PLEASE NOTE

HORSES/PONIES MUST HAVE BEEN VACCINATED IN THE 12 MONTHS PRIOR TO, BUT NOT WITHIN 7 DAYS OF THE COMPETITION.

PASSPORTS WILL BE CHECKED ON ARRIVAL AT THE COMPETITION VENUE.
Please allow extra time for this.

SHOOTING

PROTECTIVE OR PRESCRIPTION GLASSES ARE COMPULSORY.

Guns must be kept in their cases until the Firing Point Steward gives the order to unbox them at the start of the detail, and must be boxed again before the competitor leaves the firing point. At all other times the guns must be stored in their boxes and locked in a secure place, for instance, in a vehicle, out of sight.

Please ensure you are all aware of THE LAW APPLYING TO THE CARRYING OF GUNS (persons of 18 years or over only). This is a LEGAL REQUIREMENT.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

Organisers of events take reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.

LEGAL LIABILITY

Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of events or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accept any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

OBJECTIONS

Any objections regarding the scoring for each discipline may ONLY be made by the TEAM MANAGER, and within 20 minutes of the scores being displayed.

CANCELLATION

In the event of cancellation of the Dri-Tri, the entry fee less £10 to cover administration costs, will be refunded.
