## ENTRIES

1. **All entries are subject to a non-refundable Horse Events booking fee of £2 per rider.**
2. **Entries close on Monday 13th June.**
3. If you have made entries directly, amendments can be made by logging into your Horse Events account under “My Bookings”.
4. If you need to cancel an entry or change a class before the closing date, please email [info@horse-events.co.uk](mailto:info@horse-events.co.uk).

6. The competition will be run in accordance with the Pony Club Eventing Rules 2022
7. Substitutions may only be made in accordance with the Pony Club Eventing Rules 2022. Please email your changes to [info@horse-events.co.uk](mailto:info@horse-events.co.uk).

## RULES

1. The competition will be run in accordance with the Pony Club Eventing Rules 2022 (<https://pcuk.org/media/hs3jrvkc/eventing-2022-final.pdf>) and in line with the Government’s prevailing Covid restrictions at the time.
2. In the event of abandonment, 25% of each individual entry fee will be retained to defray expenses.
3. **Refunds:**
  - i. **100% up to 11am on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> June 2022**
  - ii. **No refunds after 11am on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> June 2022**
4. Please avoid bringing dogs if possible – if they have to come, they must be kept on short leads **at all times** and there will be a fine of £10 for any contravention.
5. Water will be provided near the lorry park.
6. The Judges’ decision is final. In the event of a dispute or objection arising, **an objection in writing together with £50 must be lodged with the Secretary within 30 minutes of the incident.** Any appeal will be heard by the Jury of Appeal. The decision of the Jury will be final.
7. Hats must be tagged with an aquamarine tag and body protectors must be to BETA 2009 Level 3 standard (purple label) or BETA 2018 Level 3 standard (blue and black label).
8. Three competitor numbers must be printed on A4 by competitors and brought to the competition. No printed numbers will be provided by the Organisers. Print templates will be available at [www.ponyclubresults.co.uk](http://www.ponyclubresults.co.uk). **Please display one number in the front window of your vehicle.**
9. Courses will be open for walking on Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> June from 2pm.
10. Please obey parking stewards at all times.
11. All competitors must travel with equine passports and comply with the Pony Club Vaccination Rule in the Eventing Rule Book 2022. **Please note that at competitions at Area level and above, the most recent booster injection must have been given within the six calendar months prior to the date of the competition. No horse or pony may compete on the same day as a relevant injection is given or on any of the 6 days following such an injection.** Spot checks will be undertaken during the day.
12. Photographic Rights – competitors and their parents/guardians have given permission for any photographic and/or film or TV footage taken of persons or horses/ponies taking part in Pony Club

events to be used and published in any media whatsoever for editorial purposes, press information or advertising by or on behalf of the Pony Club and/or Official Sponsors of the Pony Club.

13. The Organisers reserve the right to alter or amend any aspect of the competition.

**HEALTH AND SAFETY** Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all the Officials and Stewards.
