Class 5 30 – 40 cm not assisted

RULES, REGULATIONS AND LEGAL LIABILITY

- Combination one pony/rider can enter a maximum of two classes only. Rider can have more than one combination.
- PONIES can enter more than two classes BUT different combination
- Competitor Age limit
 - Classes 1 – 5 Maximum age 14 but aimed at younger riders and those wanting to gain experience.
 - Classes 6 - 7 14 years and under
- ASSISTED One responsible individual in the arena with the rider at the same time who may accompany the rider and give assistance VERBALLY. The assistant is NOT permitted to have physical contact with rider or pony (ie not hold pony or rider in any way) until the round is finished. Should physical contact be made the entry will be deemed as an HC round.
- Classes 1 – 6 run as single phase
- Penalties
 - Knock down - 4 penalties
 - 1st disobedience - 4 penalties
 - 2nd disobedience - 8 penalties
 - 3rd disobedience – elimination
 - Fall of rider/horse, course error – elimination
- In all Pony Club Show Jumping, excessive use of the whip including repeated slapping down the shoulder is prohibited. The rules state that the whip may be used a maximum of three times during a round. Use of the whip will be monitored and excessive use may result in elimination at the discretion of the judge.
- All competitors must have their hats tagged.
- **HEALTH AND SAFETY** Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all the Officials and Stewards.
- **LEGAL LIABILITY** Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the Organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the Organisers of any event to which these rules apply, nor the Pony Club, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
