CLASS 1 – PC Grassroots Dressage Test 2018 **OR** PC Introductory Dressage Test 2019

CLASS 2 - PC Novice Dressage Test 2019 **OR** PC90 Eventing Test 2013

CLASS 3 – PC Intermediate Dressage Test 2013 **OR** PC100 Eventing Test 2015

CLASS 4 – PC Open Dressage Test 2019 **OR** PC110 Eventing Test 2010

What you need to know before you enter

1. Any rider of 16 years of age and under must have parental permission
2. **Horse and rider combinations** may not enter a class more than one level below their highest entry in any competition class – eg if you have entered an intermediate test, you cannot enter an Intro test
3. **Late entries:** The closing date for each competition is 23:59hrs on the last day of the month. After this time entries and videos cannot be received and no refunds will be made. Results will be posted 1 week later.
4. **Videos of tests must not be entered if they have already been judged in another competition.** Any video which is suspected of having been filmed during another competition will not be accepted and no refund will be offered. **For this reason if competition clothing is worn, then the horse or pony must wear boots or bandages.**
5. You are riding at your own risk. Correct riding attire and appropriate protective wear **MUST** be worn eg, riding hat, suitable footwear, hairnets and gloves for safety reasons.

Filming:-

1. The person videoing needs to be **standing behind C**, holding your phone **landscape** and **zooming in** at the A end of the school. You need to be in a marked arena with correct measurements either on grass or in a school
2. Ask your 'filmer' (kindly) to try their hardest to keep you in the centre of the screen at all times

3. The video **must have sound** – you may have a caller for the test but you **may not** have training help.
4. Your video must have **NO cuts**. It must start at least 2 seconds before the rider enters at A and preferably 4 seconds after the rider salutes at the end.
5. The person videoing or calling your test **MUST** introduce you, the horse, the date and the test you are riding at the beginning of the video.

Tack & Turnout

1. Show attire is **not required** but if a show jacket or hacking jacket is worn, then the horse or pony must wear boots or bandages to clearly demonstrate that the test has not been recorded at a competition.
2. **Riding hats** must be worn. **Suitable footwear** with a heel and **gloves** must be worn for safety reasons. Long hair to be in a hairnet.
3. **Bridles**– For Introductory and novice tests – ordinary snaffle bridle; Elementary and above – ordinary snaffle or double bridle. Nosebands must be worn, a drop, cavesson, grackle or flash with a snaffle or a cavesson with a double bridle.

Uploading your test

YouTube – Upload your video to YouTube and then email the link to Jo Baker-Tuck at beaufortdressage@gmail.com along with confirmation that you have paid your entry fee. If your entry fee has not been paid, your test will not be judged.
