


This risk assessment covers the Pony Club members who assist with the running of the Badminton Horse Trials by collecting the jump judges slips and taking them to the scorers.

Water and food available for both riders and ponies.</p> <p>All riders to carry a fully charged mobile phone to be used in an emergency only.</p> <p>All responsible adults of slip collectors to carry a fully charged mobile phone. Pony Club Slip Collector Organiser to have a list of all mobile phone numbers of adults and riders.</p> <p>All riders waterproof clothing and other requirements from the Health &amp; Safety briefing to be taken to their course section base by responsible adult. All to be wearing long sleeved white shirts and Pony Club ties as per Health &amp; Safety briefing.</p> <p>UV levels at this time of year can be very high so sun cream should be considered even on a cloudy day.</p>
