

A message from your DC:

How to fix your Beaufort Logos to your numnah and make them look smart.

1.	Purchase your logos via Alex Connors alex@bestboots.co.uk. The logos have been manufactured exclusively for our club and they are on sale at £12/pair. They can be fitted to your own “square” numnah which should be clean and WHITE ONLY.
2.	More recently supplied logos come with 4 x 45mm safety pins. If you need some, please ask Alex nicely 😊 and collect them from her.
3.	Separate the embroidered part of the logo from the velcro layer. Attach the velcro layers to your numnah using <u>TWO</u> safety pins per logo. Make sure the pins are <u>close to the edge</u> of the velcro. Attach one logo to each side of your numnah in the position and orientation shown. The logos should be HORIZONTAL.



4. Carefully position the embroidered layer of the logos directly on top of the velcro layers. Line them up straight and press firmly to ensure the two layers are firmly attached together.



The logos should not curl away from the numnah. They should lie “flush” to it. DO NOT put your logos through the washing machine. Sponge clean only when necessary. In between uses store FLAT. If they have been allowed to curl, immerse in water and leave to dry pressed under a weight.

Please Note: If you are using a numnah with an existing embroidered logo, this is only acceptable if you can cover the existing embroidery ENTIRELY. Our logos are the maximum permitted size under PC rules. Any logo markings extending beyond it will render the numnah ineligible for PC use.
