




Included but not limited to ridden activity, officials checks</p>	<p>PC Members, Coach and spectators may become injured if crush or impact occurs by being kicked, trodden on or crushed by close proximity to a horse.</p>	<p>PC Members. PC Officials. Parents. General Public. Animals. 

