




Guns - Law relating to carrying and use air pistols.	PC Members. PC Officials. Parents. General Public. Animals. Property.	Display notices detailing the requirements for the use of air pistols. All guns boxed except at firing point. Supervision of competitors by 2 qualified RCOs. Stewards briefed. .177mm calibre pistols used with wad cutter pellets to minimise risk of injury.	Hall time booked the day before (Sat 12 th Feb 22) to allow for careful set up and checking ahead of the day.
Range – Stray Shots, Changing Targets	PC Members. PC Officials. Parents. General Public. Animals. Property.	Range set out and distances measured by RCO Firing Point Steward (qualified RCO) in control of shoot., giving specific commands to load and shoot. Safety briefing for each detail. Safety flags to be used (new rules 2022) Automatic turning targets used. Targets changed with guns 'broken'. Energy absorbing material behind targets. Access to range controlled by a steward. Backing to range made from Airbag material, Tried and tested by Area 10 and by Philip Hobbs Pentathlon GB shoot coach. Airbag material covered with further layer of dust sheets in case of bounce back. Additional steward to collect competitors targets. All competitors shooting at 7m must wear safety goggles.	Send out info to competitors in advance regarding new safety flag rule. Provide strimmer cord (used as safety flag) on the range for anyone without. On advice of HQ use this competition to educate competitors in the use of safety flags rather than impose rule strictly.

Swimming Pool – Drowning	PC Members. PC Officials. Parents. General Public. Animals. Property.	Qualified lifeguard familiar with the pool and the location of emergency equipment. Warm up heats throughout competition to control numbers in the pool at one time. No diving into water unless instructed they may do so. Height of starting blocks checked Safety announcement to all competitors Stewards in charge of competitors Only one coach/parent allowed at one end of each lane.	Qualified swim coach in charge of swim phase. Additional marshals to line up and send forward children in heats. Additional Lifeguard provided by TAZ on poolside throughout.
GENERAL – The Activity Zone	PC Members. PC Officials. Parents. General Public. Animals. Property.	No overflow car parking, use designated parking only.	Parking steward with radios to manage parking, only allowing cars into the sports centre car park when spaces are available. All competitors warned that parking is limited so please allow extra time for arrival and please lift share where possible. A flow of traffic from sports centre to run phase and back again should free up parking spaces in a rolling fashion all day. Scorers and organisers are mindful to get results out quickly for all classes, distributing rosettes at regular intervals in order to allow early competitors to leave the site without delay.
RUN PHASE at Park Farm Run Phase: Slip, trip or fall	PC Members. PC Officials. Parents. General Public. Animals. Property.	Map of route displayed Any significant trip hazards have been identified and removed or segregated. Run markers to help ensure direction of runners is established. Red and white markers to run between red on right white on left. Start and finish clearly identified to keep the public and supporters off the running route The phase steward to walk the route to check for any natural holes e.g roots, badger or cattle ruts and fill in as required. Run has a timed start in heats to limit the number of competitors on the course Marshall deployed out on the course to support in case of first aid and assistance Medical conditions are managed in line with the rulebook First aid provision are in place in accordance with the pony club rules Extreme weather needs to be considered and amendments made as needed to the route In extreme weather water or additional clothing needs to be available to members	During the event, ensure controls and compliance are monitored.
