PC Members. PC Officials. Parents. General Public. Animals. Property.	It is the riders/handlers responsibility to ensure their horse is under control at all times. Spectators are allowed only in the corner with the bench while the rally is in progress. Pedestrians stood in close proximity to horses must be responsible for their own safety and the possibility of crush from hoof to foot contact. Pedestrians and handlers should avoid standing directly behind horses. Any horses that are known to kick must wear a red ribbon in the tail. All riders must wear an approved riding hat at all times when mounted in compliance with PC rules. Congestion building up with horses around entrances to the arena must be monitored and riders/handlers will be asked to move away to create space.
