1. This competition will be run in accordance with the Pony Club Eventing Rules 2024. Eligibility rules for Area Qualifiers do not apply.

2. The decision of the Judges, Organisers and Jury is final. They reserve the right to alter, amend or cancel any part of the competition, or refuse entry without stating a reason.

3. In the event of cancellation, the entry fee less £15 to cover administration costs, will be refunded.

4. Entry Fees will only be refunded up to the closing date, 31st May. After this date, refunds are at the organisers' discretion.

5. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

6. HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.

7. **HATS** meeting current Pony Club standards (as in the 2024 rule book) MUST always be worn when mounted. All hats must be correctly fitted and tagged.

8. **BODY PROTECTORS**, which are up to the current Pony Club standard (as in the 2024 Rule book) are recommended for Show Jumping and are compulsory for Cross Country. Competitors wearing body cages MUST leave the key with the Secretary before they go Cross Country. If a rider chooses to wear an air jacket, it must only be used in addition to a normal body protector. 9. **SPURS** are not allowed in classes 2, 3 or 4.

10. Any queries or complaints must be in writing and handed to the Organisers within 30 minutes of the incident together with a fee of £20 which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.

11. Ponies may compete in a maximum of two classes HOWEVER they can only go round twice if AT LEAST ONE of the two classes they participate in is ASSISTED.

12. No competitor may ride more than two horses/ponies. This will be at the discretion of the organisers and in the event of oversubscription riders may only be allowed to ride one pony.

13. NO STALLIONS.

14. Competitors must present themselves to the steward for tack inspection at least 20 minutes before their dressage time.

15. Competitors who are eliminated in the Show Jumping phase may go Cross Country only with the permission of the show jumping officials with emphasis on the safety of the child. 16. There will not be a farrier on site.

17. Forbidden Assistance Outside assistance is forbidden under penalty of elimination. Any intervention by a third party, whether solicited or not, with the object of facilitating the task of the competitor or of helping his horse, is considered forbidden assistance. If, in the opinion of the Official Steward, the assistance was unsolicited, and the competitor gained no advantage then no penalty will apply.

Helpful Hints for Beginners

- Ponies and riders should be neatly turned out, with beige jodhpurs, a jacket, tie and PC badge for dressage and show jumping and gloves for dressage. Riders may wear coloured shirts for cross country.
- A solid coloured numnah (contrast piping allowed) and girth for dressage and show jumping.
- For dressage you may carry a whip, but your pony must not wear a martingale, grass reins (except Classes 3 & 4), boots or bandages. You are encouraged to use a neck strap.
- All long hair and all girls' hair, unless very short, must be secured in a hair net.
- Prize giving must be attended in your dressage clothes and with your hat.
- Body Protectors are compulsory for cross country and they must comply with 2024 rules BETA 2018 Level 3.
- Hats must be tagged as per Pony Club 2024 rules.
