After the closing date withdrawals are non-refundable unless there is a waiting list. Any refunds after the closing date are subject to an admin fee of £10. The booking fee and card processing fee is not refundable at any time.

In the event of abandonment for any reason 50% of the entry fee will be refunded from closing date to 17.00hrs on the day prior to the event after which there will be no refund. When refunds are due these will be processed back onto the card you paid on.

Prizegiving will take place after each class at the secretary's tent and prizegiving times will be posted via the event Whats App group. Dressage sheets can be collected from the secretary's tent prior to prizegiving. All prize winners must attend prizegiving in riding kit to include hats.

Prizes to 3rd place for PC teams and PC individuals Rosettes to 10th place for all classes and 6th place for PC teams.

There will be catering, a tack shop Indy Equine Photography and Equireel on-site.

A vet, doctor and farrier will be present at the event.





ENTRY CONDITIONS

- To be run in accordance with Pony Club Eventing Rules 2024
- The decision of the Judges, Organisers and Jury is final. They reserve the right to alter, amend or cancel any part of the competition, or refuse entry without stating a reason.
- Please ensure your members comply with 2024 eligibility, hat tagging, body protector and medical armband rules and have a responsible adult present.
- Late entries may be accepted at the organiser's discretion if there is space. Late entry surcharge £10.
- Queries on the day may only be raised via the Secretary by the DC or their appointee.
 Protests/objections will be managed as per Rule 15.
- No horse may compete in more than one class on the day.
- No lungeing or exercising in the lorry park and no horse/pony to be left tied to any trailer/lorry unattended.
 - Please pick up your droppings/hay around your trailer/lorry and take home with you.
- Photographic Rights competitors and their parents/guardians have given permission for any
 photographic and/or film or TV footage taken of persons or horses/ponies taking part in Pony Club
 events to be used and published in any media whatsoever for editorial purposes, press information
 or advertising by or on behalf of the Pony Club and/or Official Sponsors of the Pony Club.
- A valid passport and vaccination record must accompany the horse/pony to this event and must be
 available for inspection if required by event officials. Vaccinations must be in accordance with the
 Pony Club Eventing Rule Book 2024 i.e. all horses/ponies attending must have been vaccinated
 against equine flu within the last 12 months of the competition date.
- The event may be cancelled without notice. This will be announced on the Event WhatsApp group so please sign up to it. It is also recommended that you check the Pony Club Results website before departing.
- Please note that no dogs are allowed
- All rubbish to be taken home
