- 4. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

BODY PROTECTORS, which are up to the current Pony Club **standard** (as in the 2025 Rule book) are recommended for Show Jumping If a rider chooses to wear an air jacket, it must only be used in addition to a normal body protector and in the event of a fall, it must be removed or deflated before continuing.
- 8. Children are only allowed to wear spurs if they have passed their spurs test or passed their spurs test and have the yellow tag on their hat.
- 9. Any queries or complaints must be in writing and handed to the Organisers within 30 minutes of the incident together with a fee of £20 which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
- 10. No cantering outside the rings and warm up areas.
- 11. All dogs must be on a short lead at all times. Please kindly clear up after your dog.
- 12. There will not be a farrier on site.
- 13. Non-Pony Club members must have their own insurance.
