- 1. This competition will be run in accordance with the Pony Club Rules 2025 The decision of the Judges, Organisers and Jury is final. They reserve the right to alter, amend or cancel any part of the competition, or refuse entry without stating a reason.
- 2. In the event of cancellation, entry fees £10 to cover administration costs per rider, will be refunded by 16th July 2025
- **3.** Entry Fees will only be refunded up to the closing date, 9th June 2025 After this date, we will make a refund on receipt of a doctor/vet certificate if we can fill the place from a wait list.
- 4. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
- **5. HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY.** Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring, and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.
- **6.** HATS meeting current Pony Club standards MUST be worn at all times when mounted. All hats MUST be tagged with a PINK hat tag, any hat without a tag must be brought to the Secretary's tent when collecting numbers to be checked and tagged.
- **7.** BODY PROTECTORS, which are up to the current Pony Club standard (as in the 2025 Rule book) are recommended for Show Jumping If a rider chooses to wear an air jacket, it must only be used in addition to a normal body protector and in the event of a fall, it must be removed or deflated before continuing.
- 8. SPURS Rider must have achieved C+ riding or the Spurs Test AND Hats must have a new YELLOW spurs tag if the competitor wishes to wear spurs in any class.
- 9. Any queries or complaints must be in writing and handed to the Organisers within 30 minutes of the incident together with a fee of £20 which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
- 10. NO STALLIONS.
- **11.** No cantering outside the rings and warm up areas.
- 12. All dogs must be on a short lead at all times. Please kindly clear up after your dog.
- **13.** There will not be a farrier on site.
- 14. Non-Pony Club members must have their own insurance.
