Information:

All classes will have a timed section with a gate. Results will be firstly on clears round the whole course, then the fastest time through the timed section wins!

Pairs classes will have dressing fences with points awarded awarded 1-5 by the judge and these points equate to seconds which will be deducted from your time section. Eg you take 40 seconds in the time section and you score 3 for the dressing fence. Your time becomes 37 seconds.

There will be L fences with a 15 point penalty or black flag fences that will take a longer route.

Maximum two cross country rounds per horse/pony. Please bring sufficient water supplies/attire for the weather for you and the horse.

Rosettes 1st to 10th in each class.

A prize will be given to the best Beaufort Pony club member in each class.

Dress: Please wear cross country or hunting attire. Bring your own number bib and we shall provide you with a link to print your own numbers.

Please be aware that **all riders**, including non Pony Club Members, **must wear a Pony Club approved TAGGED hat** and a **Body Protector that meets BETA 2018 Level 3.** All non Pony Club members must also have third party liability insurance to compete. Evidence of this may be asked for on the day.

Spurs: PC members can only wear spurs if they have the yellow Spurs Hat tag. Misuse of Spurs by ANY competitor will result in Elimination.

The course may be walked from 2pm Saturday 25th October. Dogs must be kept on leads AT ALL TIMES including during course walks.

Rules and Conditions of Entry

This competition will be run in accordance with the Pony Club Eventing Rules 2025.

The decision of the Judges, Organisers and Jury is final. They reserve the right to alter, amend or cancel any part of the competition, or refuse entry without stating a reason.

Entry Fees will only be refunded up to 20th October 2025.

- DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their of negligence, breach contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
- HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY. Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring, and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.
- HATS meeting current Pony Club rules MUST be worn at all times when mounted. All hats must be correctly fitted and tagged. There will be a tack inspection at the start.
- BODY PROTECTORS meeting BETA 2018 level 3 standard are compulsory for cross country. If a rider chooses to wear an air jacket, it must only be used in addition to a normal body protector and in the event of a fall, it must be removed or deflated before continuing.
- PC MEMBERS are only allowed to wear spurs if they have passed their Spurs Test or passed their C+ Riding Test and have the yellow tag on their hat. Spurs tagging cannot be performed on the day.
- All horses/ponies to be at least 5 years old.
- All Horses/ponies attending Beaufort Hunt Pony Club Events must have a correct vaccination history and have been vaccinated against Equine Flu within the last 12 months. There will be random passport checks.
- It is the parent/rider/handler's responsibility to ensure their horse is under control at all times and to ensure all horse tack is safe, sound, secure and fits correctly. Any unsafe behaviour or behaviour deemed detrimental to a horse or pony's welfare (e.g. excessive use of the whip or spurs) may at the organisers' discretion result in the competitor being asked to leave the course.
- Any scoring queries should be reported QUICKLY and POLITELY to the secretary's tent. If a child's score is under query, please would a responsible adult make the query WITHOUT the child present.

No cantering outside the rings and warm up areas.

There will not be a farrier on site.

Non-Pony Club members must have their own insurance.
