

1. This competition will be run in accordance with the Pony Club Eventing Rules 2026. Eligibility rules for Area Qualifiers do not apply.
2. The decision of the Judges, Organisers and Jury is final. They reserve the right to alter, amend or cancel any part of the competition, or refuse entry without stating a reason.
3. In the event of cancellation or abandonment after the closing date, 50% of the entry fee will be refunded.
4. Entry Fees will only be refunded up to the closing date, 27th May at midnight.

5. **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY** Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

6. **HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY** Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.

7. **HATS** meeting current Pony Club standards (as in the 2026 rule book) **MUST** be worn at all times when mounted. All hats must be correctly fitted and tagged with a PINK tag.

8. **BODY PROTECTORS**, standard BETA 2018 Level 3 with Blue & Black label (as in the 2026 Rule book) are recommended for Show Jumping and are compulsory for Cross Country. Competitors wearing body cages **MUST** leave the key with the Secretary before they go Cross Country. If a rider chooses to wear an air jacket, it must only be used in addition to a normal body protector and in the event of a fall it must be removed or deflated before continuing.

9. **SPURS** are not allowed in classes 2, 3 or 4. Rider must have achieved C+ riding or the Spurs Test **AND** Hats must have a new **YELLOW** spurs tag if the competitor wishes to wear spurs in Class 1.

10. Any queries or complaints must be in writing and handed to the Organisers within 30 minutes of the incident together with a fee of £20 which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.

11. Ponies may only compete twice

No competitor may ride more than two horses/ponies. This will be at the discretion of the organisers and in the event of oversubscription riders may only be allowed to ride one pony.

12. **NO STALLIONS.**

13. Competitors must present themselves to the steward for tack inspection at least 20 minutes before their dressage time.

14. Competitors who are eliminated in the Show Jumping phase may go Cross Country only with the permission of the show jumping officials with emphasis on the safety of the child.

15. There will not be a farrier on site

Class 1 MINI - 70cm (Teams & Individuals)

Dressage Test: Foundation PC70 Dressage Test 2026 (may be ridden in any normal bit)
Show Jumping & Cross Country: Approx 70cm

Class 2 VERY MINI - 60cm (Teams & Individuals)

Dressage Test: Introduction to Dressage Test 2019 (may be ridden in any normal bit)
Show Jumping & Cross Country: Approx 60cm

No spurs will be allowed in this class.

Class 3 EXTRA MINI - 50cm (Individuals only)

Class 4 EXTRA EXTRA MINI – 40cm (Individuals only)

Class 4A Assisted – all disciplines (assisted = lead rein or ANY assistance/contact with pony or rider)

Class 4B Unassisted – all disciplines

Rosettes for the top 3 children aged 8 and under in Class 4B
Dressage Test: Walk & Trot Dressage Test No.2 2026 (may be ridden in any normal bit)
Show Jumping & Cross Country: Max 40cm

Please see PC Dressage Rules 2026 for further details on permitted bits and grass reins.

No spurs will be allowed in this class.

- **This event is not suitable for horses**
- Dressage tests may be called in all classes.
- All classes are run over a short cross country course and are ideal for those competing at this level for the first time.
- Some classes may do their XC before their show jumping.
- In classes 3B and 4B should a parent need to step in and help to ensure enjoyment and safety they may do so and continue for the rest of the phase with a penalty of 200 points added to the final score (only added once not for each discipline)

Refunds of entry fees will be given if the entry is withdrawn prior to or on Wednesday 27th May 2026. The booking fee is not refundable at any time. In the case of abandonment 50% of the entry fee will be refunded.

Helpful Hints for Beginners

- Ponies and riders should be neatly turned out, with beige jodhpurs, a jacket, tie and PC badge for dressage and show jumping and gloves for dressage. Riders may wear coloured shirts for cross country.
- A solid coloured numnah (contrast piping allowed) and girth for dressage and show jumping.
- For dressage you may carry a whip (max. 102cm measured up to tassel), but your pony must not wear a martingale, grass reins (except Classes 3 & 4), boots or bandages. A breastplate or neck strap is encouraged.
- All long hair and all girl's hair, unless very short, must be tied in a hair net.
- Prize giving must be attended in your dressage clothes and with your hat.
- Body Protectors are compulsory for XC, HIGHLY RECOMMENDED for Show Jumping and recommended for small children at all times when mounted. They must comply with 2026 rules- BETA 2018 Level 3 (blue and black label)
- Hats must be tagged as per Pony Club 2026 rules. NO FIXED PEAKS for cross country phase.
