

Rules

1. To be run under the [Pony Club Show Jumping Rules](#).
2. Open to all Pony Club members (25 years & under) and **NON**-Pony Club members (18 years & under). Age as of 1st January 2019.
3. Stallions are not permitted at this event.
4. A combination of horse and rider may enter up to **2 height classes**. The height classes must be of consecutive heights. No horse can compete more than once per class; permission may be given for a 2nd HC round with a sibling.
5. Classes will be run in numerical order and the course will be available to walk before the start of each class. Competitors will jump in numerical order. Class start times and numbers will be available on the website prior to the competition. Any competitor who misses their turn may be disqualified at the judges' discretion.
6. No ponies that are registered as JA under BS rules may compete.
7. Hats. It is mandatory for all competitors to wear a protective helmet at all times when mounted with the chin straps fastened and adjusted so as to prevent movement of the hat in the event of a fall. The hat must be manufactured to one of the minimum standards listed in the [Pony Club Hat Rule 2019](#). Hat checks will be carried out. All hats must be tagged with either an **aquamarine** Pony Club, British Eventing (BE) or British Riding Club (BRC) hat tag; this can be done on the day.
8. The decision of the judge is final and any objection must be made to the Secretary with a deposit of £10, refundable if the objection is upheld.
9. The organisers reserve the right to disqualify anyone for misuse of whip or spurs, dangerous riding or any horse in poor or lame condition.
10. "HC" entries will be accepted if classes are not full at close of entries.
11. Horses/Ponies must not be left unattended at any time, or left tied to the outside of lorries or trailers.

Legal Liability Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event nor The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

Health and Safety The organiser of this Event has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser and all officials and stewards.

Insurance Non-Pony Club competitors are not covered by The Pony Club Insurance and must have their own third-party cover. The Belvoir Hunt Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members and their insurance will not cover you.

Dress & Tack Code

Jackets plus Pony Club tie for members. All competitors must wear jodhpur / riding boots and stirrups should be of the correct size to suit the rider's boots. They must have 7mm (¼") clearance on either side of the boot. Body Protectors are optional, air jackets are not encouraged if used in restricted spaces with other horses and ponies in the immediate vicinity. **Grass reins are not permitted but Daisy reins may be used for courses of up to 50cm.**

Venue

Parking will be on hard standing. Please could you ensure that you clear up any droppings left by your horse / pony and please don't tie haynets up outside your trailer. Dogs must be on leads.

Refreshments including hot food will be available.

Equine Influenza

Laughton Manor is following the current BEF guidelines re Equine Influenza immunisations. For all horses that are currently vaccinated they recommend that horses/ponies receive a booster if it is longer than 6 months since their last booster, however all horses must have received a booster vaccination within the last 12 months.

The competition organisers will be carrying out spot checks on arrival at Laughton. Please have your pony/horse's passport with you and be ready to show the immunisations schedule. Please do not bring your horse/pony to the competition if any horse at your yard is showing any symptoms of being unwell.
